CHAPTER XXI

THE SEVENTH TRUMPET

Chapter 11, verse 15 of Revelation reads: "AND THE SEVENTH ANGEL SOUNDED; AND THERE WERE GREAT VOICES IN HEAVEN, SAYING, THE KINGDOM OF THIS WORLD ARE BECOME THE KINGDOMS OF OUR LORD, AND OF HIS CHRIST; AND HE SHALL REIGN FOR EVER AND EVER." These words or this great announcement will be uttered by the voices of seven thunders. Already we have noticed what the seven thunders have said; for there is nothing more in the mysteries of God that stand passes the seven thunders in this world. This is the last act of the drama of life, but we will review the seven thunders a little at this point. The angel having declared that in the days of the seven angels, when he shall begin to sound the mysteries of God shall be finished (Revelation 10:7 [see appendix]). The angel further declared that there would be time no longer, for the prophet was about to write, but there was nothing more to write at this point (Revelation 10:6 [see appendix]).

Now back to verse 15 (above) of Revelation 11th chapter. When the seventh trumpet sounded, the great declaration from heaven ended the mysteries of the Little Book whose content was hidden from the Prophet Daniel. The seventh trumpet is the last act. When the work is carried out under it as we shall notice, the mysteries will be finished. With this point, your attention is next called to Revelation 16th chapter of this text.
