The President is a Weak Man!!

Dear HOZ:

In that we have been instructed by the Lord to watch and to give meat in due season, we must not ignore the facts of the prophecy of Zerubbabel and what the Lord told him would occur in this same hour that the kingdom has been turned over to the beast (Rev 17 v17). The prophet did hear the angel of the Lord say, "The president is a weak man." The prophet identified this to mean – and shared this with us – the following points:

- 1. The president's policies of government, which were given forty and two months to implement (Rev 13 v5) will and are being seen (by large segments of the nation) as ineffective and weak.
- 2. These policies are being dictated not by man, but by the two-horned beast of Rev 13 v11; the two-horned beast has been given full authority to dictate destructive policy through whomsoever sits down in the office of the head of the United States' government regardless of that leader's political affiliation or personal intent (Rev 17 v17).
- 3. This dictation from evil shall consistently denote weakness and an inability to govern effectively in the eyes of his or her political enemies. In addition, along with this comes a condition of perplexity within the policies of the government even though the authority and control over the events of this hour is not in the hands of man!!
- 4. The U.S.'s problematic state of affairs shall consistently be compounded by the executive judgment of Christ, being carried out in the form of natural disasters, calamities and economic chaos. THIS IS THE PROPHECY OF ZERUBABEL! (Ref Scriptures: Isaiah 22 v5; Micah 7 v4, line 2; Luke 21 v25)

- He is perceived by some to lack the knowledge to reestablish the nation's hold as the number one economic engine on earth. The nation, under his watch, has lost their number one credit rating in the world; and though he is not the blame, he is being blamed for it by his political enemies.

We at this time should be looking for every opportunity to improve our righteousness, improve our patience and our trust in God, for these are the fulfillments to the prophecies of Zerrubbabel, and precursors to the coming ambush of executive judgment of God (Rev14 v6; Jer. 51 v12). We read in Amos 5 v20: "Shall not the day of the lord be darkness, and not light? even very dark, and no brightness in it?"

We Must Now Trust in God!!

Dear beloved HOZ, we are now officially in the hour of the "time of trouble". Every thought the dragon can muster against a saint's trust in God shall he bring forth as an arrow of attack. We must guard against him by prayer and seek not our own, but the "spirit of poorness" so that we may constantly feel each other's cares. Whoso putteth his trust in the lord, shall be safe."
