Dear HOZ:

This letter is to congratulate all HOZ and those whom stand with HOZ in doctrine and in faith and has held on to the sweet peace of Jesus – regardless to the intensity of the attack of the dragon.

Night Dream (3/8/12)

"I saw myself and two other members of HOZ moving furniture from a large house sitting upon a hill. As we stopped to rest for a brief moment, suddenly there was a large, rumbling noise of power and force that was heard all around us. As we looked upward towards the house on the hill, a giant title wave of water appeared behind the house. It seemed to raise several stories higher than the house itself. It moved forward and completely covered the house. We were in shock and amazement that the house was not moved. No damage to the house was visible to us. The house divided the waters by its firm stand. The waters could not move the house and was forced to divide into three smaller streams of water. One gush of water – over the top – itself was deflected and redirected by gutters and steep roofing. The rest divided into two small streams on both sides of the house, which became even smaller as it rushed down the hill towards us whom were standing at the bottom of the hill watching all this. By the time the waters reached us, the streams were very light with hardly any force of power at all. The two slight streams of water passed by both sides of us as a small flow with all power diminished."

As we look upon this dream, Wisdom leads us to a cluster of bible scriptures that we might completely understand its meaning. The house was in representation to the purity of the law and testimony...unchanged and unmixed (Rev. 7 v13-14; Rev. 14 v4; Matt. 25 v1-4). Further, we were assured by God that as long as we kept our doctrine free and pure from all mixture we would be impregnable (Matt. 7 v24-25).

My Sheep Shall Hear My Voice

HOZ, please note that the Lord Christ had this to say as we read St. John 10 v3-4. We further notice in this text that the Lord made reference to us being able to recognize his voice. Mother Wisdom leads us to investigate the word "voice" by definition.

Webster on voice: "In grammar, a form of a verb showing the connection between the subjects, either as performing as in <u>active</u> voice or as receiving as in <u>passive</u> voice, the action!!!"

Thus, we do hold that our Lord by this statement was sending a signal to the saints in the last days that his voice would come to the earth and perform certain actions, which they alone would understand.

[Note: We noticed that the scriptures gave no reference to any meeting between Christ and John the Baptist after the baptism (Matt 3-13-15) However the scriptures do verify that it was by a series of actions done by Christ that assured John that he was the messiah he'd had waiting for. We further note that this was not the first time this awesome communication method of God was used to let the righteous know that the God they served and were waiting for had arrived. An example is found in Luke 7 v20-23. These texts bare witness of the "actions" done by the divine power of the word of God. In verse 22 the Lord states, "Go thy way and tell John what things ye have seen and heard; how that the <u>blind see</u>, the <u>lame walk</u>, the <u>lepers are cleansed</u>, the <u>deaf hear</u>, the <u>dead are raised</u>, to the poor the gospel is preached." From this text and others we are made to understand that our God is a God of "Action" and also his voice is a voice of action as seen in Rev. 19 v15.]

What is relayed here is that the Lord can **summon his own voice to go before him**; it comes forth out of his mouth as a spirit power, detaching itself from his person to do his bidding. In 2 Thess. 2 v8, we can see here that it is called, **"the spirit of His mouth".** The reason for this is to protect his creation from the awesome magnitude of power bestowed upon him at the coronation in heaven...a gift from the Ancient of Days for the completion of his salvation works as seen in Eph. 1v19-23, Phil. 2 v5-11and Rev. 5 v6-12. Because of his awesome glory, no flesh could stand before his physical person before they become eternal. Thus, he protects his creation by sending forth his voice to do his bidding, which again comes forth in the splendor and light and power of his divine testimony (Apocrypha: Judith 16 v14 and Rev. 1 v10-17).

Therefore, we note that whenever the voice of God arrives, it is there to conduct some type of action on the behalf of God. Mother Wisdom points us to the experience of Adam. When Christ sent his voice down to the garden to check on Adam (Gen 3 v8-10), we see here that Adam hid from the voice of God (which was stated to be *walking in the garden in the cool of the day*). We do hold that the appearance of this voice creates a trumpet-like sound (Rev. 1 v9-10); this is the voice of Christ and to look upon it you would first see the power of his testimony as in Rev. 1 v12-13. [Note: I hold this to be the same voice that did deliver the "Message of Elijah", which is upheld by the power of his testimony, as in Zech. 4 v2-6 (also verse 9-10 of this same chapter). Again, this voice has arrived and is directing the angels of God into action as in Rev. 19 v10.]

Now as we think upon these things, by the word of the Messenger of the Covenant, James T. Webb (surnamed Zerubbabel), we already do understand that Christ will make his next physical appearance at the opening of the sixth seal, which 1) brings forth the resurrection of the dead saints, 2) by which he shall destroy the Man of Sin and 3) make ready for the great battle between Good and evil – using the fourteen plagues (Rev. 6 v12-17 and 2 Thess. 2 v8-9). However, while on this side of the dark days of judgment...before the coming of Christ to the sixth seal...the Lord promised us that he would send his voice; and that his voice would speak in a language that we would understand. Furthermore, he would teach us how to read the language of God, which is a language of physical deeds of action, powered by the testimony of Jesus (Apocrypha: WOS 1 v7 and St. John 10 v16).

By this refreshing knowledge, I am made to understand and do firmly hold that it was the announcement to the earthly arrival of the voice of Christ – sent to the earth by Christ our God – to activate and put into action that which was spoken and prophesied by the Messenger of the Covenant, James T. Webb. This announcement was made unto me not by night dream or vision, but an actual and physical occurrence in my life that happened thirty two years ago.

OCCURRENCE

I had worked the night shift on my job and just arrived home. It was very early in the morning and my wife and three small children were asleep. As I lay down next to my wife and closed my eyes, instantly three tones of a trumpet blew exceedingly loud in my ears. I could not open my eyes due to brain freeze from the sound. Each musical tone was an octave higher than the first. When the tones of the trumpet subsided, I immediately jumped up to see where the sounds came from. I checked every room in the house, but to no avail. I even looked outside to see if the neighbors had made that sound, but no one was outside or even close to my home. I awoke my wife, but she heard nothing. I wondered, how was this possible, so I immediately left to see the Prophet Webb, who explained that he did not hear the trumpets and could only wait for me to tell him what they were. For the next ten years, I tried to gain insight from the Prophet Webb on this matter, but his answer was always the same; "You tell me!!"

Thus, now 32 years later, by the power and force of the testimony of Jesus Christ, my Lord and savior and by the grace and directives of our Heavenly Mother and Divine Queen, Mother Wisdom, I do hold that the experience of John the Revelator seen in Rev. 1 v10-12, was also my experience. I am now persuaded that the three tones of that day were the voice of Christ saying, "I HAVE ARRIVED!!!" Here was the fulfilling of the promise of Christ to his elect: "*MY SHEEP SHALL HERE MY VOICE*." (St. John 10 v16)

Once again, as we examine these things, we look to the word of God for assurance and clarity. The Prophet Webb taught us to check all things by the bible and to make sure of righteous application. We do note that Paul made note of this spirit power coming out of the mouth of the Lord to destroy the antichrist in 2 Thess. 2 v8; it reads, "And then shall that wicked be revealed whom the Lord shall consume with the "spirit of his mouth". John-the-Revelator also gave witness to this incredible power proceeding out of the mouth of the Lord in Rev. 19 v15, quoting, "And out of his mouth goeth a sharp sword, that with it he should smite the nations." It is at this time I am persuaded that the spirit of his mouth as noted by Paul, whom John did identify as a voice having the sound of a trumpet, was the same that came into my home 32 years ago: having the sound of a trumpet and blowing three consecutive tones. These tones being now interpreted unto me by the actions taken in the "Message of Elijah" in the forms of earthquakes announcing the arrival of Michael and the division of lion angels. In addition, other physical deeds and calamities that we all have witnessed, signifying the coming activation to the judgment of Christ as prophesied by the Prophet James T. Webb, surnamed of God, Zerubbabel, the Messenger of the Covenant.

As God allows us to think upon these vast and divine powers of God, we already know and understand that the Lord's power is beyond human description; however, Mother Wisdom is many thousand times more loving than our earthly mother and wants us to understand as best we can the power and divine love of our heavenly father, his greatness and his majesty. Thus, we hold at this time that the physical person of Christ, having been made equal to the Ancient of Days due to his salvation works, would deactivate the earth upon contact due to our condition of sin (Rev. 6 v13-17). Therefore, it is within the divine order of God that he send the spirit of his mouth (his voice!!) to the earth ahead of the arrival of his physical presence. With the actions of this great power of Christ, our Mother Wisdom would then convert them into signals and give the saints...of that hour...the power to interpret these signals so that they might not be caught unaware in the judgment (St. John 10 v16).
