



TOPIC: OPEN OUR EYES TO JAMES FIVE

**SUB-TOPIC: 1) ECONOMIC TURMOIL
2) VISION OF THE PROPHET WEBB**

Scriptures:

James 5th Chapter

Key: James 5 v4

“Behold, the hire of the labourers who have reaped down your fields, which is of you kept back by fraud, crieth: and the cries of them which have reaped are entered into the ears of the Lord of sabaoth.”

Isaiah: 21 v6

“For thus hath the Lord said unto me, Go, set a watchman, let him declare what he seeth.”

Dear friend and reader:

Before we begin we would state that We, surnamed HOZ by the spirit of God, do write unto you in complete humility and in the fear of the Lord. Having no skill, knowledge or power of perception above any other man on earth, we write unto you by inspiration of God. Being influenced only by the commandments of God and the testimony of Jesus Christ, which is the spirit of prophecy (Rev. 19 v10 and Isaiah 8 v20) and is our guiding light and the driving force behind the hope of our salvation, it is by direct commandment from the full throne of God (as in Isaiah 21 v6) that we write unto you. Therefore, we do live in the hope that none be offended in our writings, for it is not by our own will that we come unto you, but by the will and purpose of our God. (*Terald D. Blakey Sr.*)

We, having been given the “spirit of the watchman” from the Wisdom of God (the mother of all heaven and all the intended creations and saints of God) it is by this spirit that we do direct you to our first letter in our heralding news section of this www.Godssaints.org website entitled, *As We Bare Witness*. We employ you to read the entire letter for complete understanding from the Wisdom of God, for she is the mother of all saints of every race, creed, color and nation. Furthermore, it is she who will feed any that seeks the truth (Ephesians 3 v9-10). However, on the fourth page of this letter under the subtitle, *Kingdom of the Beast*, part two, the campaign of the two-horned beast against mankind was addressed. It was noted how the evil forces from hell have arrived from hell and have setup through their own wicked seed on earth the **first stage** of worldwide, economic persecution against the poor. Nevertheless, we must remember that in our quest for salvation from God we “wrestle not against man”, but evil spirits (Eph 6 v12).

At this point we ask you to turn on your television, or pick up any newspaper or turn on any radio and you will see for yourself that the word of God is in fulfillment even as we speak. Thousands of people all over the world, in many, many nations, are protesting economic tyranny imposed upon the poor by the rich as again is seen in James 5 v1-4; verse 4 quotes: ***“Behold, the hire of the labourers who have reaped down your fields, which is of you kept back by fraud, crieth: and the cries of them which have reaped are entered into the ears of the Lord of sabaoth.”***

[Note: The definition of fraud according to Webster means: a deliberate deception perpetrated for unlawful or unfair gain; a trick or swindle or cheat.]

Be it known unto all that the Lord has withdrawn the **“spirit of deal”**, which makes it possible to have fair and perfect balance within the world’s economic system (Rev. 6:5); once this spirit has been withdrawn it then becomes **impossible** to have that balance. Through the satanic spirit of greed we have come to this hour. We now must experience the prophecy of Daniel, by whom this hour was called “a time of trouble” (Daniel 12 v1). This time of trouble is indeed the world’s initiation to the executive judgment of God as preached and prophesied and foretold by James T. Webb, messenger of the covenant (Rev. 1 v1 and Rev 14 v6-7).

Economic Turmoil

Friends, as mentioned previously, the forces of hell – referred to as the dragon within the scriptures as in Rev12 v3 – have started an evil crusade against man that has began with economic turmoil, which shall become very sever and merciless in power and cruelty (Dan. 12 v1 and Rev. 13 v8-18). We cannot call upon God to save us from this condition, for this condition is the will of God (Rev. 17 v17); it shall end at the battle of evil against good called, Armageddon. We invite all to witness with us the fulfilling of the word of God as mentioned to the Prophet Esdras in II Esdras 9 v1v5 (the Apocrypha). It states: ***(V1) “He answered me then and said, measure thou the time diligently in itself: and when thou seeest part of the signs past, which I have told thee before, (V 2) then shalt thou understand, that it is the very same time, wherein the highest will begin to visit the world, which he made.”*** Also we notice the angel’s statement to the Prophet Esdras in verses 3-4 concerning the earthquakes and uproars among the people. We have already been alerted in regard to the recent diverse earthquakes that have showered our world as of recent. These earthquakes were indeed caused by angelic movement as in the days of the resurrection of Christ (Matt 28 v2). Now, we do see “uproars among the people of the world” – in every nation concerning the persecution of the poor.

[Note: The significance of this uproar, verses any other event of the past, is that it involves the entire world around one single issue...the world’s economy!! This directs us to the prophecy of the Apostle James (5 v1-4) and the prophecy of James T. Webb. For further clarification please see our letter in the document library entitled, The Great Economic Snare.]

Now, let us return to the Prophet II Esdras 9 v1-5. In verse two we notice that the scripture says, ***“He will begin to visit the world, which he has made.”*** The Webster dictionary tells us that the word “begin” simply means the start of a process. We again notice that the scripture says, ***“He answered me then and said measure thou the time diligently.”*** Thus, at this point the question must be asked, ‘By what means and process do we, as human beings, measure time and angelic movement?’ James T. Webb, the true and only prophet sent by God in our time, was given a measuring rule by God in vision. With this measuring rule – placed in his mind by angelic tutoring – the angels of God did deliver unto him the skills to both understand and interpret the angelic movement to the purpose of God (Rev.1 v1).

Vision of the Prophet Webb

“I was in a room, which were both a church and a home. My wife was teaching the children. As I stood on the rostrum of the home, there was a glass enclosed chest, which had three bibles in it. The large one was on the bottom and the medium sized one on the top; and yet still another small bible was on the top of the two and still another little book was on the top of the bibles. There were two ink pens on the little book, which was closed. The pens wrote in two colors, one was red and the other green. Then in a later vision, I was walking towards a little room or a one-room building in which I worked on the works of God. The message and all writing were done there. As I walked the angels put manuscript titles of my works in my hands. Then he placed a foot rule in my hands and at last the little book, which was on the bibles in the chest, he placed in my hands.” (1770)

We also have this same foot rule taught directly to us by the Prophet Webb, so therefore we can use it to examine both the angelic movement in respect to prophetic events among the people, along with the rise and fall of nations. Again dear reader the foot rule given to the prophet was for the measurement of the movement and purpose of our God’s angelic forces as they execute the will of God in judgment. Please examine with us Zechariah 4 v8-9 and Rev 1 v1. Now notice with us a remarkable thing. In Zech 4 v6 the Lord promises great spirit power to Zerubbabel, and by this spirit power of knowledge the Lord reveals unto him the great spiritual mountains of good and evil (as promised in Zech 4 v7, Psalms 36 v6 and Rev 17 v3-9). Next, in Zech 4 v9-10 the Lord transfers these great spiritual skills from the hand of Zerubbabel to his hands, which is HOZ, and by this action God preserves and protects the truth to the message of the covenant against the war with the dragon (Rev 12 v17). In verse ten of Zechariah 4th chapter; it declares the transferring of the plummet that by definition is an ancient measuring tool. The eyes in the plummet are the seven spirits of God that comes directly to us from the body of the Lamb in the form of a doctrine called the Testimony of Jesus (Rev 5 v6). This doctrine is the spiritual key that opens up the word of God and makes it understandable and perceivable to the saints (Rev 19 v10). As we have mentioned throughout this website, James T. Webb – who died in December, 1989 – was a major prophet surnamed of God, Zerubbabel. God not only transferred the spirit of the ancient Prophet, Zerrubbabel, to him for the rebuilding of the Tabernacle of David, but also made him the “Signet” to the preaching of the everlasting gospel and the judgment of God as seen in Rev 14 v6-7 and Haggai 2:21-23.

[Note: Webster on “Signet” means to speak by order of the king. This king, we know, is none other than Jesus Christ, our God.]

After finishing the writing of manuscript booklets (in which he was commanded to send to the leaders of the world warning them of this hour, which were completed in the 1950’s) the Prophet Webb was instructed by the Wisdom of God to set up a church called the Tabernacle of David as foreseen in the book of Acts (Acts 15 v14-16). He was later instructed to set up a school system within this little church. The school system would be utilized by God to set both into motion the plans of salvation and the execution of the judgment of God. The administering of the confirmation of the new covenant taught by James T. Webb through the Sabbath school would supply the spiritual oil and wine to the saints of God called the wave sheaf (Rev 6 v6). This oil and wine would prepare them for the marriage of the king’s son as seen by Mathew (Matt 25 v4-10). Here the stage is now set for the deliverance of Israel as was seen by Daniel (Dan 12 v1-2) and Isaiah (Isaiah 66 v7-8; Rev 12 v1-2; Romans 11 v25-26), which was to come after the gospel dispensation as was noted both by the prophets of old and the disciples (Acts 15 v14-16).

We hope it is clear to you dear reader that the judgment of God has indeed come, and may the sweet peace and hope of God be forever within your heart.
