Dear reader, dear friend:

By the power of my faith I was instructed of God to call those that have served the Lord with me in the bringing forth of the "Message of Elijah" and speak unto them. Mother Wisdom's instructions were to place all our focus on Hebrews 11th chapter – the power of God's faith – for we are the direct descendants of Abraham, the first father of the showing of faith (Heb 11 v8-10). If we truly believe that we are the direct descendents of Abraham, and that we have the faith of Abraham within us, it is here during the third distress (as prophesied by James T. Webb) that God will require a display of that faith from us all. We know that God sent Abraham looking for a city that was over four thousand years in the future, a city that had not been constructed yet. This city, whose streets were made of Gold and precious minerals, did not exist on earth; and yet, he traveled thousands of miles (on foot) looking for the promises of God. Abraham just obeyed God, not really knowing in what direction he was headed or how far he had to go (Heb 11 v8). Abraham offered up his son for sacrifice, believing in the promises of God.

To proclaim that we are the descendants of such a man with such faith is a monumental claim, which God will test us as he tested Abraham and found him worthy. Fear not! Our test is already underway. We, whom God have raised up to bring forth the "Message of Elijah", began this task of God with no direction, knowledge or information as to what our purpose was. We just followed the voice of the spirit that first demanded righteousness and then time and sacrifice from us all. The contents of the "Message of Elijah" are in the perfect order of God. Being all truth, it is without error and falsehood; to this fact I say all praises be to God. Now the Wisdom of God, who gave us the "Message of Elijah" now, requires her messengers to display the faith of Abraham in the message they produced and carried out. Amen!

Death is no Obstacle

Dear reader let us now examine the word of the Lord in 2 Cor 1 v10, quoting "Who delivered us from so great a death, and doth deliver: In whom we trust that he will yet deliver us." Now please examine Rev 1 v18, which quotes, "I am he that liveth, and was dead; and behold I am alive forever more, Amen; and have the keys of hell and death." I hope it is clear here that the faith of the saints of God must exceed the temporary holds of death, for our Lord did mention that he has the keys of death and can release one from its grip in the twinkling of and eye as see in 1 Thess 4 v14-16. We, who are saints of God, must hear the Lord's voice on this fact and believe it, for it is true. Death is not the dominant power on earth...JESUS CHRIST is! It does not matter how long one has been dead to God, when God says live, he will live!! (Note: Ezek 37 v 5-14)

Dear reader, if you believe in the power of God, the deliverance of God, that you are the descendents of Abraham and have the faith of Abraham in you, here is where your belief shall be tested by God. If you do believe that:

- The bible is the word of God,
- James T. Webb was, and is, the prophet of the New Covenant of God and the messenger of the judgment of God
- He (James T. Webb) held the signet of the Lord as in Haggai 2 v21-23,
- He (James T. Webb) was, and is the messenger of the Everlasting Gospel of God as in Rev 14 v6 and 7;

Then, all is well because our Lord, by the power of his death, abolished the permanent power of death on earth (2 Tim 1 v10).

The first man, called Adam, did sentence us all to permanent death in the earth because of his <u>disobedience</u> to *his* God, but our Lord Jesus Christ released us from that sentence by the power of his <u>obedience</u> to *his* God. Thus we must now take Wisdom's hand and pronounce within our selves that death is not an obstacle to our belief.

They are not Dead...but Sleepeth

Again dear reader, the Wisdom of God would have us to review the report of the disciples concerning their eye-witnessed account of the power of resurrection that was displayed by Jesus Christ, our God (Matt 9 v23-25; St John 11 v38-44). Here we have it; the Wisdom of God and Jesus Christ, our heavenly parents, are with us and they are the principle powers behind our message. Thus, they are requiring us all to pick up our faith and believe in the power of God. Jesus Christ, our God, not only rose up these people, but when he was executed at the hands of Rome and the Pharisees, His full power was restored to him by his father, the Ancient of Days. He then resurrected himself, forever breaking the grip of death that the kingdom of the dragon placed on man when they brought to the earth the power of death, received from the incomprehensible, dark antimatter of the forbidden zone. It was here that Christ restored mortality back to man with the promise of eternal immortality to come (1 Cor 15 v54; 1 Thess 5 v10). Amen!

The Return of the Man-child:

Dear faithful of God, please examine with me this cluster of scriptures by which Mother Wisdom will reveal to us the next step of her plan of salvation: the return of the Man-child to announce the finishing of his work. At this time the Wisdom of God has directed me to the works of James T. Webb and his booklet, entitled, *It is Finished: the Declaration of the Seven Thunders*.

It is here that mother wisdom wants us to focus on our faith. I am coming at you with the statement of the prophet in paragraph 1, line 5 quoting, "But as for the vision of the little book which was given unto me by the angel in the room, I was given a golden letter, which I was to read at the finish. Now my work is finished and the little book is sealed." Here we notice that the prophet's focus is on the finishing of his work, which is **not** finished until the Tabernacle of David church is restored to the Lord as seen in Amos 9 v11. In many past treatise the prophet did explain that he thought his work was completed when his preaching by written booklets to the Seventh -day Adventist church, the Church of God and Saints of Christ, and the government leaders were completed. This occurred at the end of the 1950's. At that time the prophet got the word from heaven that he would be in eternity within ten years. He then thought that meant deliverance, but it was not to be so. It did mean that within ten years the "atonement" and "heavenly judgment" would occur and the Gospel Dispensation would end. However, the prophet did not know at that point that he was to rebuild the Tabernacle of David. This was told to him later, and to the prophet was transferred the "Spirit of Zerubbabel" (the old ancient builder of God's Temple) for the rebuilding of the church to come **after** the Gospel Dispensation (Ezra 5 v2; Amos 9 v11; Acts 15 v14-16).

Thus, Bro. Webb founded and rebuilt the Tabernacle of David church as Mother Wisdom commanded him to do. God poured out his spirit from heaven and awoke the seed of Israel as to their true identity as promised in Joel 2 v28 and Deut 28 v15-53. The spiritual blindness is forever removed by God as in Romans 11 v25 and the spirit of question is placed among the people as in Mark 1 v27. These questions led to a lot of street-talk that ended up introducing the people to James T. Webb, Prophet of the Most High God, along with his righteous and well-schooled family. By word of mouth the news of the truth escalated and traveled, attracting both *good* and *bad* to the church as was stated in Matt 22 v 8-10. The prophet taught the church and gave it the pure word of God (Isaiah 8 v20; Rev 19 v10; Eph 3 v9and 10). The church was founded on the seven spirits of God and placed on the doorstep of Mother Wisdom to await the rain of its deliverance as was stated in Joel 2 v32 and Zech 10 v1.

Nevertheless, in the formation of the church during the gathering again we state came the *bad* as well as the *good* mentioned in Matt 22 v10. These are the rotten corn of Abbaddon whom the devil manipulated into the harvest of God. It is through them the devil would start the war of Rev 12 v15-17. The devil taught them false meekness and tactics of manipulation while in the world. It is through these tactics the devil did push them into the leadership of the church. Here they would await the demise of the Prophet Webb (who became old and sickly) to bring about policies of ungodliness that would remove the church from the doorstep of Mother Wisdom and make them ineligible for the latter rain (Rom 11 v26). Yet God cannot be defeated. Her (Mother Wisdom) plan was to transfer the "spirit" of Zerubbabel to certain saints gathered in his harvest. It is through them that the oil of Wisdom would be restored to the church, placing it back on the doorstep of God to await its deliverance. These servants, the scriptures referred to as the "hands" of Zerubbabel (Zech 4v6-9). Zerubbabel was led by the Wisdom of God to groom these servants for this hour and nothing could...... or would...... stop their emergence to defend the church of God against the policies of the dragon. It is by the "hands" of Zerubbabel that James T. Webb's work would be finished as stated in Zech 4 v9.

The Wisdom of God directs us to the book of Zechariah again noting, chapter 4, verse 9, line 1; and it quotes, "*The hands of Zerubbabel have laid the foundation of this house*;" This line refers to the foundational works of James T. Webb in the 1970's in respect to the building of the Tabernacle of David Church under the specific guidance of the Wisdom of God, the mother and queen of heaven, and the architect of the plans of salvation (Ezra 5 v2; Matt 22 v8-10; Eph 3 v9-10). We go back to Zech 4 v9, line two, "*His hands shall also finish it.*" This statement refers to the transfer of spiritual knowledge and skills by way of specific grooming at the hands of Zerubbabel himself to certain servants that the Wisdom of God led him to choose. This self-same thing occurred between Elijah and Elisha (2 kings 6 v6-14) and Moses and Joshua (Num 27 v18-20). Now at this time, under the New Covenant that was preached by

James T. Webb, God has again transferred the spirit she created within Zerubbabel to his hands (i.e., meaning those whom Bro. Webb relied upon for specific and major tasks in respect to the grooming, teaching, edification and wellbeing of the church. These are they who never failed to answer the call of the prophet and searched diligently the word of God in service of the Lord and edification of Wisdom's baby church).

[Note: Here the Wisdom of God asks that we refer to the vision of James T. Webb in the treatise entitled, "<u>It is Finished: Declaration of the Seven Thunder</u>, page 5, paragraph 1, line 5; "But as for the vision of the little book, which was given to me by the angel in the little room, I was given a golden letter, which I was to read at the finish." Thus, God would have us to now focus on what happens at the finishing of the work of the prophet. By vision he was shown that he must read the golden letter given him by Christ himself at "<u>the finish</u>". But we ask ourselves, how can this be? for James T. Webb was taken from among us by death!]

Again we return you to Zech 4 v9. Wisdom now declares unto us that the work of the prophet shall be finished by the hands of Zerubbabel as declared plainly in our text of study. Further we were told by Zerubbabel himself that the "Golden Letter" is a divine document written on something from heaven itself; it is the hand writing of Christ himself. It (the letter) has raised letters coming off of the paper in all seven colors of the rainbow that represent the seven spirits of God issuing forth out of the Lord's body. This is <u>not</u> a document that can be held by *mortal* hands (but only after the mortal body has been changed as seen in 1 Cor 15 v54)! Therefore, Mother Wisdom guides us further for clarity and absolute truth of this matter.

We go back again to the scripture in Zech 4 v9; "And thou shalt know that the Lord of host has sent me unto you." NOTE CLOSELY: Here is the return of James T Webb, also known as the Man-child (meaning first born of Wisdom) himself, having been delivered from death! Isaiah 66 v7 quotes, "Before she travailed she brought forth, before her pain came she was delivered of a manchild." Here is the deliverance of James T. Webb from death as in seen in Romans 7 v24 quoting, "O wretched man that I am! Who shall deliver me from the body of this death?" Also we see in 2 Cor 1 v10 as it quotes, "Who delivered us from so great a death, and doth deliver: in whom we trust that he will deliver us." James T. Webb, otherwise known as the Man child and surnamed of God Zerubbabel, shall return to us delivered from death as was written of him. Mother wisdom directs us to read on in verse 10, "For who hath despised the day of small things? For they shall rejoice, and see the plummet in the hand of Zerubbabel with those seven."

God wants us all to know that it was a small thing to deliver Zerubbabel from death. Furthermore, the plummet in his hand represents the complete measurement of all things that he did in the service of God. It is the declaration of the finishing of his work; thus, the plummet is the "Golden Letter" itself!! Speaking of the plummet, please notice that it has seven eyes coming off of it, for the scripture says, "...and shall see, the plummet in the hand of Zerubbabel with these seven." These are the seven spirits of God placed on this document by the hand writing of the Lamb of God, which is Christ seen in Rev 5 v6; it quotes, "And I beheld and, lo, in the midst of the throne and of the four beast, and in the midst of the elders stood a lamb as it had been slain, having seven horns and seven eyes, which are the seven spirits of God sent forth into all the earth."

Going back to Zech 4 v11-14, this text of scriptures refers to the hands of Zerubbabel that God used to produce the "Message of Elijah". The oil is the knowledge of grooming that Zerubbabel himself did place within them during his time of mortality. The letters of Wisdom, produced by them, represents this oil of Wisdom that shall be shared with the saints that God leads to them by the spirit of question seen in Mark 1 v27 and Matt 25 v4; "But the wise took oil in their vessels with their lamps." These are they whom shall return to the God of Israel after being discarded (unrighteously) by the satanic policies of ungodliness forced on the church by the ancient men (Note: Rom 11 v26, Ezek 9 v4-6, Isaiah 34 v8 and 11and Isaiah 9 v15.) These selfsame servants, who return to God shall by the power of the Wisdom letters, be reborn by the same rebirth of knowledge given to the Man-child (Rev12 v5).

These (the returning saints) shall reunite with the saints already within the church; i.e., those that have the mark of God and have been spared in the judgment of God by the Eagle Angels that shall enter the church and remove the tares (Ezekiel 9:4-6). For the *returning* saints, and the *remaining* saints, this rebirth of knowledge *is* the oil. This rebirth of knowledge is the oil they missed from the Sabbath School after being discarded from the church by the leadership. This oil is also the *former rain of knowledge* needed to prepare them for the *latter rain of deliverance* and change as seen in Zech 10 v1, Joel 2 v32 and Dan 12 v1.

At this time we will go to the works of the Prophet Webb on this, the <u>Message of Elijah</u>, and its role in the judgment of God. Here the prophet will let us know exactly what to expect and what to look for in this, the judgment hour. We must remember that we, the Tabernacle of David church, did emerge from Laodicea, which was the last of the Sabbath-day keeping churches ordained by God.

Bro Webb's booklet, *The Deadly Wound is Healed*, page 4, second paragraph, line thirteen quotes, "The Lord will suddenly visit Laodicea in a great Message of Elijah, which is a power in his hands to clean house. Guile and false doctrine will be the issue and many people will get the surprise of their life. (3rd paragraph) "Here straight truth will uncover every error and every hidden thing to the church of the doctrine now taught. The effect will cause a great upheaval in the church when decisions will be taken on the issue: the testimonies of Jesus Christ or the testimonies of the Mrs. White. As the Message of Elijah becomes a reproof and correction, a message of rebuke, repentance and decision, much sorrow and tears are in store as the message is brought to bare against the house of God for the third and last time. Please notice that it was used by Elijah himself in the days of Ahab, King of Israel and in the days of John it was again by the power of Elijah, and for the last time in our day (Malachi 4 v4-5). Notice further that the Message of Elijah always comes before great events in the earth."

The prophet continues on page 5: "Following sharp on the heels of the message, it also will become a media of separation in the church as decision is being made. Many will be spewed out of his mouth (Rev 3 v16). Now understanding is that the spewing out is a matter of decision taken on the issue. This is a process by which the wheat will be separated from the tares."

Dear reader, I hope it is clear that the prophecy of Bro. Webb makes clear of the hour in which we face. As we stated before, the church (Tabernacle of David) is now seen under the symbol of the church of Laodicea. In addition, just as Mrs. White was seen/known as a "false" prophet of that time, we are now also dealing with "false" prophets today.

Once again let us return our attention to Bro. Webb, who is the Man child as in Isaiah 66 v7. We notice that the Manchild will receive his deliverance <u>first</u>, for it was said, "...<u>before</u> she travailed, she brought forth, <u>before</u> her pain came she was delivered of a Man-child. The "she" mentioned here is the Mighty Wisdom of God, for she is with child, which is the deliverance of the church as in Rev 12 v1-2. Here it is said that she travails to be delivered; yet, the Prophet Isaiah was shown the Man child receiving his deliverance.....<u>first</u>! This is not the same as the resurrection of Israel mentioned in Dan 12 v2, but a special resurrection given to the Man child alone...coming <u>before</u> the House of Israel is resurrected as in Isaiah 66 v8. It is here that he (Bro. Webb) shall come unto us with the "Golden Letter" in his hand – referred to as a plummet – representing the finishing of his work as in Zech 4 v9-10.

All praises be to the full throne of God, and a special salutation and praise goes to our Heavenly Mother (the queen of all the *intended* creations of God) and the architect of the great plan of salvation by which we all are reborn to the heavenly family. Amen! Amen! Amen!
