Who is Your Mother?

Answer: The Wisdom of God in perfect splendor! (Proverbs 8th and 9th chapters; Ecclesiaticus 24 v1-3, Apocrypha)

No man can perceive or explain the magnificent and divine love of God. The four beasts of the Revelations – whom God has placed in a wonderful position at the very foot of the throne, that they might bare witness to the results of his divine love – can but only say "HOLY; HOLY; HOLY...LORD GOD ALL MIGHTY!" Their minds are completely consumed by the splendor of that which they continuously witness: <u>the awesome power of the full</u> <u>throne of God</u>!

Let us all stand and give praise, worship, honor and glory with eternal thanks from the depth of our souls to our heavenly mother...the queen of all the heavenly creations of God, the mother of all the intended creations of God, the architect of the plans of salvation...**The Most Reverend and Holy Wisdom of God!** We ask at this time, "Why did we only learn of her?" Our answer is:

- 1) She is a mystery, and
- 2) She was hidden.

We read in 1 Corinthians 2 v7, as it quotes, "But we speak the Wisdom of God in a mystery, even the hidden wisdom, which God ordained before the world unto our Glory." Here she is: God Most Holy, the mother of all the creations of Christ! She is divine in every way. There is none that can stand in her path.

Therefore, now we must ask, was Mother Wisdom *or* the Virgin Mary the true mother of heaven; and if Mary was not, then who ordained her so? Our answers are as follows:

- 1) She (Mother Wisdom) is the <u>true</u> mother of heaven and <u>not</u> the Virgin Mary.
- 2) It was the Catholic Church, by blasphemy, that ordained Mary so.

We should state here that the Virgin Mary was truly the biological (in the flesh) mother of Christ, and he indeed did recognize her as such with the words, "*Behold your mother!*" We further state that she (Mary) was, and is, a blessed saint of the Lord. We are to note understand that the Lord did say that "*all that are in the graves shall hear his voice*". We must understand that the word <u>all</u> includes Mary too, since she, herself, lies in her grave (not in heaven) awaiting her reward in the resurrection of Israel (Dan 12 v2; St. John 5 v28-29).

We must further understand that at no time were we instructed by the Lord Christ or his disciples in any of their teachings to give worship to Mary. This was done by Pagan Rome after they brought an end to the persecution of the true Christians (Dan 7 v23-25 and Rev 6 v9-11), and then they "so-called embraced" the name of Christ; thus, they renamed their worship of Diana, the sun god, to Mary, the mother of Jesus. They (Catholicism) then renamed their statues of idolatry from **Diana** to **Mary**, placing them in their so-called Christian churches as icons of worship. This also was forbidden by the divine law of God (Ex 20 v4-5; Isaiah 8 v20).

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The honor of worship belongs only to the Wisdom of God, for she alone is our heavenly mother (Prov 8 v12-35). We note that:

- It was She (Mother Wisdom), *not Mary*, which ordained, taught and sent unto us both the prophets and the apostles that we might know the will of Christ, our God. In Luke 11 v49, it quotes, *"Therefore also said the wisdom of God, I will send them prophets and apostles and some of them they shall slay and persecute."*
- It was She that stood as God in the beginning of things with the Word of God, which is Christ (St John 1 v1-2; Prov 8 v22-30).
- It was She, *not Mary*, which designed the construction of the church of Christ (Eph 3 v9-10).
- The plans of salvation were written by her and by her divine power, all the acts of the plans of salvation are justified (Matt 11 v19).
- It was Mother Wisdom, *not Mary*, which designed the souls of men and set up the pathways of destinies for the saints of God before they were born into this world. [Note: In Ecclesiaticus (Apocrypha) 1 v14-15 it quotes, (v14) "To fear the lord is the beginning of Wisdom, and it was created with the faithful in the womb." (v15) "She hath built an everlasting foundation with men, and she shall continue with their seed."]

Dear reader, the next questions that may arise within you are: Why are we just hearing about Mother Wisdom...and why don't the ministers of today talk about her?" The reality to these answers is:

- 1) Due to their deceitful doctrines, She hid herself, and chose that they know her not (1 Cor 2 v7).
- 2) Furthermore, if one does not keep the "law and testimonies" as his/her doctrine and way of life, she will not reveal herself to them (Eccl, Apoc: 1 v26).

So the scriptures clearly show and help us to see that She, the Wisdom of God, is very particular to whom she reveals herself to (Eccl 6 v22). Here is what is meant when it is said, "*To know God is life eternal*." Amen! However, the final question that is most relevant to us is:

Question: How can we thank our Mother/God for all that She has done on the behalf of our soul's salvation?

Answer: We cry out unto her and she hears our voices; and as a tender, loving mother, she has come to redeem man. Amen!

Every child should know its mother!
