## Your Home: Your Sanctuary - Part IA

## Isaiah 8:20 and Revelations 19:10

To God's Saints – who have been estranged from and longed for the joy of worshipping God in the spirit of truth:

The devil has attacked you unjustly and placed upon you accusation after accusation; blame after blame and mental persecution without cause. At this hour it is time to "forgive yourself", for the Lord has already forgiven you. Do you need a place to worship God because you refuse to attend the churches of organized religion? Or have you perhaps, and your spirit is still not at peace because you are not getting the spiritual food you need or desire? You are not forsaken. Understand this important message of the hour: Use Your Home as Your Sanctuary!

It would be better to use your home as a family altar because you are dissatisfied with organized "religion" and the existing eldership, policies and leadership of your present church or house of worship, for any reasons, such as the following:

- You have been, for any reason, removed from your church family and congregation.
- You are, or have unjustly received a dis-fellow, have been excommunicated, "put on high", "put on the bench" or estranged from your church family.
- You are not encouraged by your church's doctrine and policy or mainstream religions that violate the commandments and testimonies of Jesus Christ (i.e., Catholicism and its sister religions and denominations).
- Your pastor advocates and preaches a ministry of prosperity and wealth <u>before</u> teaching and supporting the word of Christ.
- You are fearful and dissatisfied with the church leadership or eldership and their policies of personal gain and control.
- Your parents have, or would abandon you and your siblings because of church policy and the fear of reprisal and punishment.
- Church politics, as well as separate rules, privileges and protection are given to favorite members or families that give the most, or simply hold positions of control.
- You are tired and simply just have had enough and want to change your life and do not know what to do or where to go.

If any of the above should apply to you, please read 1<sup>st</sup> John 4:1-3. There are many false prophets and you can tell them by the fruit they bare. "*The Lord's sheep shall hear my voice*", thus saith the Lord. He is now calling his saints home (1<sup>st</sup> John 4:4).

## We exhort you: Today, while it is still called today, come out of her my people!

We ask now that you please read Hebrews 3: 1-16. Come out of her organized religious blasphemy; "Babylon has fallen" (Jeremiah 51: 47-49; Isaiah 21: 9-12; Revelations 14:8). Churches and religion (i.e., Catholicism and its orthodoxy, Anglican, Protestant, Lutheran, Puritan, Methodist, Apostolic, Calvinism, Episcopal, Baptist, Mennonites, Amish, Islamic, Buddhist, Jehovah Witness, Latter Day Saints, Atheist, Paganism, and all the rest of its sister religions and denominations) have become the *habitation of devils* and hold to every foul spirit and cage of every unclean and hateful bird (Revelations 18-2). Today, it is be better to use your home as your sanctuary. Additional reference to this point can be found in the following scriptures: Jeremiah 27:14-18 and 2<sup>nd</sup> Peter 2:1-3.

Again Saints, we can see "Time" suggests that it is better for you to worship God in your home. Use your home as your sanctuary to seek God in the Spirit of Truth, in accordance with the Commandments and Testimony of Jesus Christ (Mark 13:28-30). Fear not...especially man... and go in prayer to knock at the door of God; ask him to release the spiritual chains and millstone of fear and lies and the abominations around the neck of you and your family (Rev 3:20-22). It would be better to use your home as the family altar. Remember, where there are two or more gathered together and speaking in the name of our Lord, Jesus Christ, he is in their midst (Matthew 18:20). Fear not (Palms 56:10-11). This is the conclusion of the matter... Seek the Lord and keep his commandments and testimonies, this is the whole duty of the saints of God, both Jew and Gentile.

If your church is not Christ centered, I urge you to leave that religious doctrine and its teaching now. Come to Christ, and live according to the Commandments of God and Testimony of Jesus Christ. The "decisions" of the church's leadership and eldership . . . are to be made in all <u>righteousness</u>, <u>in holiness and lowliness of heart</u>; <u>meekness and long suffering</u>; in <u>faith</u>, <u>virtue</u>, <u>knowledge</u>, <u>temperance</u>, <u>patience</u>, <u>godliness</u>, <u>brotherly kindness</u> and <u>charity</u>.
