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## What is the 2024 Congrès mondial acadien?

The Congrès Mondial acadien (CMA) has been held every 5 years since 1994. It lasts 10 days and includes Acadian National Day celebrations on August 15<sup>th</sup>. This celebration brings together Acadians and their descendants from everywhere from Acadie, Canada, Louisiana, USA, France and around the world. It has been held in southern New Brunswick (1994), in Louisiana (1999), in Nova Scotia (2004), in NB's Péninsule acadienne (2009), in the Madwaska area of NB, Maine & Québec (2014) and on Prince Edward Island & Southeast NB (2019).

**Its mission is to fortify the ties among Acadian communities around the world. You will participate in selected CMA events including the Opening Day Festival in Clare (August 10), the National Acadian Day in Yarmouth (August 15) including the famous TINTAMARRE parade and the Saturday Night Party in Yarmouth (August 17).**



## Where is the 2024 CMA being held?

Located near the town of Yarmouth, the Acadian region of Southwest Nova Scotia is comprised of the municipalities of Clare and Argyle. Together, they form the largest concentration of Acadians and francophones in rural Nova Scotia. Acadian pride is clearly evident all-over Southwest Nova Scotia. From the road signs to the flags that fly on building fronts to the decorations that adorn the homes, the Acadian colours are an integral part of the region's visual landscape. The Acadian region of Southwest Nova Scotia is ready to welcome the Congrès mondial acadien in 2024!

## When is National Acadian Day and how do Acadians celebrate?

La Fête nationale de l'Acadie was proclaimed in 1881 and since then it keeps on getting bigger every year, with hundreds of thousands of Acadians donning red, white and blue costumes with a yellow star to sing, dance and make noise during our famous **Tintamarre** parades where we pound on pots and pans with spoons making enough noise for the world to notice that we are still here, alive, happy and energetic, more than 265 years after the tragic Grand Dérangement!

## Where is your historic Acadian Homeland?

The cradle of historic Acadie is in what is nowadays the Annapolis Valley of mainland Nova Scotia. You will have an incredible journey through time to the land of your ancestors, starting with the settlement of the Acadians in the early 1600s in **Port Royal**, to the tragic events of the Grand Dérangement in **Grand Pré** and other Acadian villages to their triumphant return and transformation into a modern-day society.

## Who is the Canadian tour organizer?
