Approval of February Meeting Minutes

Randy moved to approve as written. Florin seconded. The motion carried unanimously.

Maintenance Officer's Report

Florin reported there haven't been any big changes. 117 had an oil change just a couple of days ago and fixed a light and antenna. 9MA only has 11 hours on the current oil change. 88L is overdue for an oil change and Jon will change it tomorrow. Florin reviewed the open items on the fleet, but none appeared to be small enough to do at the same time as the oil change. Jon will do the checks on the checklist when he does that oil change, when we get plane captains, they will do those checks. A couple of the planes need pitot-static checks. Florin tried to get Cornerstone to do those checks, but their machine is out for service. Florin can get one of the planes done at Spencer's on the 26th, and is trying to find a slot for the other. Florin will also check at Tacoma Narrows. Jon notes the person at Olympia will travel to do the work. Florin will call them tomorrow.

Treasurer's Report

Safety Officer's Report

Randy reports there has been a meeting about the pattern with the helicopter folks and fixed wing pilots. The report is published on the airport web site.

Old Business

Insurance Review John tabled it, but we are not at 100% responses. John will send reminder messages to the laggards. Question from the floor: are our members covered when they are using Basic Med? Answer: yes. **Social Activities** Scott talked about a barbeque at the field or a function at Bandera or elsewhere. There are several sites where some could fly and others drive (Bandera now has gates). Scott still thinks an optional social function would be good for the club. Question from the floor: is this to recruit young people into aviation? Scott answers no, this is to meet members and their families. Comment from Mark Kornei: something like a barbeque at the airport in the summer would work, and Mark Kornei would be willing to make his facility available for a club meeting in the winter. Comment from the floor: we should just pick a target date. John notes July 21/28 are Saturdays. Comment from the floor: if we are doing it in the summer, perhaps we should do two events. Perhaps one should be a barbecue at the airport and the other something else. Mark notes his place has seating for ~30. Scott will pick two dates.

ADS-B Question from the floor: where are we? Answer: John says we will wait for Sun and Fun to see what our options are, then we may survey the membership to see what they want. Question from the floor: can we book a shop now? Answer: they won't book until we know what we want, but have said they only book about six months out. John notes all our planes have Garmin 430s which should accept ADS-B In. Comment from the floor: the

Garmin screens are pretty small to display In data. Comment from the floor: members generally fly 1.5-2 hours. If so, then do we need a really expensive unit? Perhaps that is overkill. Other commenters note our vicinity is where the traffic is that would drive the need for ADS-B In. Several commenters feel we should have dual frequency devices.
