Valley Fliers December Board Meeting

Meeting Called to Order at: 6:33

Present: Eyre, DeWitt, Botezatu, Walter, Glassmyer, Vader, plus 8 members.

Approval of November Minutes

Alan moved to approve as written. Scott seconded. The motion carried unanimously.

Treasurer's Report

See Alan's handouts. November was nearly even with last year, though our rates are higher so usage was down. Fuel costs are up 20% year over year. The accounting charges are for the club's tax return. The maintenance costs were pretty high, but \$1700 of the 63S maintenance was for the electric trim switch. The switch is not installed, but once it is, we will have replaced most or all of the trim system. Comment from the floor: 727 seems to be a very expensive airplane. It seems to be costing nearly \$60/hour just for fuel. Answer: it is fairly expensive, but Alan will need to dig into what is happening with those fuel costs. Alan may re-evaluate the hourly rate for that plane before the annual meeting. Several people comment that the airplane may need to be managed a little more closely. Commenter from the floor notes that the hourly fuel cost may drop when we get a hobbs meter in that plane. Ultimately the club's finances are good, but Alan will be watching the price of fuel. The last time fuel was this high we had a fuel surcharge. Alan is hoping not to have to reinstate one. Question from the floor: how did the fuel surcharge work? Answer: it was based on the fuel price above a benchmark multiplied by each plane's hourly burn rate. It was a complex thing for Alan to do. Scott noted that at one point we actually decreased rates because fuel prices went down and stayed low. Comment from the floor: fuel is now near \$6 per gallon, and we have two engines coming up on replacement. Alan will continue to monitor fuel prices. If fuel goes over \$6 per gallon, he might have to re-institute the fuel surcharge next month. Alan would rather keep the base rates and manage a fuel surcharge than change rates frequently.

Maintenance Officer's Report

9MA Nothing done to it last month. It needs an oil change and some other maintenance is coming up soon (mags, a torn rubber boot, etc.).

117 The primer has been squawked. The tach reads 150 RPM high. Alan noted the ELT battery is due the end of this month. Jon says he replaced it, the issue us just keeping up with the paperwork.

63S The rear jacks are inoperable. Florin will take it to Cascade. Florin had some bad interactions with them that caused him to not want to take 727 there for its GPS issues, but will take it to them for the rear jacks. The electric trim will be fixed soon.

727 the top G5 got its battery replaced and a software update. The bottom one has a decent battery, but had old software. Jon also picked up new antennas and plans to replace them. Alan asked what the bill is likely to be? The battery replacement and antennas were \$900. The software updates were free, though the labor for upgrade is chargeable. The plan is to fly the plane to the shop and have the software on both radios updated so they are in sync. Florin notes he grounded 727 from the 14th to the 20th to do the interior pieces and other work. Question from the floor: will we run the engines past TBO? Answer: we usually do as long as compression is good and we aren't making metal.

Alan asked if his squawk on 9MA's prop started the cycle of prop reconditions? Answer: yes. That squawk started things, but we found others nicks.

Question from the floor: is there a reason there is a lot of cold air coming out of the 63S trim wheel opening? Jon says he will investigate that.

Safety Officer's Report

Shawn has a checklist for $\overline{727}$ and will be distributing it. He will also update the weight and balance spreadsheet. Ed Bryce noted we are missing several electrical cords. We also need a step stool for refueling 727.

Old Business

727 GPS The GPS situation was discussed during the maintenance officer's report. Question from the floor: has the GPS had signal loss again? Answer: yes, Richard Neville reported that it failed.

New Business

Question from the floor: do we have a waiting list? Answer: yes, at least 12 people are in line.
