Attend parent night meetings and schedule parent/teacher conferences when deemed appropriate. Use the student's agenda and/or email to communicate with the teachers.	Participate in school wide activities and invest interest in improving grades and behavior.
Communication Stay Informed	Inform all stakeholders of school wide information expectations through the website, conferences, parent nights, and emails.	Update email address to receive emails from administration and teachers. Reference the website for school wide information.	Ensure the school correspondence sent home is read and that information passed from teachers makes it home to be discussed as well.
Learning Environment	Engage students in authentic learning opportunities by implementing curriculum based lessons and instruction and incorporating differentiated instruction based on data analysis.	Establish a nightly routine for completing homework, reading assignments, and discussion of the happenings of the school day.	Work to improve school work and behavior by establishing goals. Engage i meaningful academic discussion and participation.
