

The Power of Agreement

DEFINITION: Harmony of opinion, action, or character.

Agreement terrifies the enemy; division is his weapon of choice.

Amos 3:3 NKJV

“Can two walk together, unless they agree?”

We are reminded of when Man and Woman walked with God in “the cool of the day.” They were able to do this because their hearts agreed with Him. Once they believed the lies of the serpent, agreement was no longer; therefore, they had to be driven out of the garden.

Same thing takes place today: hindrances to walking with God come when we choose to entertain doubt and unbelief rather than believe what God has said to us. It starts with us...

Question: How can we be in agreement within ourselves? Yes, you heard it correctly, with ourselves. Furthermore, let us ask ourselves: “Is my mind and soul in agreement with my spirit?” The Apostle Paul spoke in Romans, chapter 7, about his body “waging war against the law of my mind.”

How do we get freedom from this fragmentation?

Hebrews 4:12 NKJV

“For the word of God is living and powerful, and sharper than any two-edged sword, PIERCING even to the division of soul and spirit, and of joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart.”

God’s word has the supernatural ability to CONSOLIDATE every area of our inner man, in order that we may step into the power of agreement.

Agreeing with God...

Matthew 18:18-19 NKJV

“Assuredly, I say to you, whatever you bind on earth shall have been bound in Heaven; and whatever you loose on earth shall have been loosed in Heaven. Again, I say to you if two of you agree on earth about anything that they may ask, it shall be done for them by My Father who is in heaven.”

When we operate with the Father in the power of agreement, we become an unstoppable force that defeats hell and expands the domain of King Jesus wherever we go.

How do we step into the power of agreement?

1. We believe what God has said.

Let us reject all the lies we have heard from the mouth of the enemy.

2. We make the decision to trust Him no matter what.

Running toward Him, forsaking all fear.

3. We obey, declaring with our mouth what he has said.

This is how we enforce what God has entrusted us with.
