

PROPOSED BY-LAW CHANGES

- 1) Change the "one meeting" months from July, August & December to <u>July, November, and December</u>.

 Note the one meeting will be held on the 2nd Wednesday (ie the first meeting of the month)
- 2) Secretary compensation raised from \$2400 to \$4800 per annum, payable monthly.

House Rules

- 3) House Rule #5 from: Appropriate attire is required at all times. Exceptions will be posted in the Bulletin. To: While there is no specific dress code, please wear appropriate clothing while attending the Lodge or Club. Certain events may have dress codes of their own to be announced beforehand.
- 4) Adding rules 16, 17 & 18
 - 16. Overservice of alcoholic beverages is forbidden in the club. Any person (member, spouse, or guest) that due to intoxication presents a clear danger to themselves or others, or that can be reasonably suspected to present a danger to themselves or others, shall be refused service. The bartender/service provider may make this decision on their own discernment. Additionally, any currently sitting Member of the Board/House Committee, not under the influence of alcohol themselves, may direct the bartender to refuse service based on the same criteria.
 - 17. Weapons are not permitted in the Lodge building.
 - 18. Use of illegal drugs is prohibited in the Lodge building.

These will be published in the April Bulletin and voted on at the 2nd April meeting.
