Mark Strynar Ph.D. is a principal investigator and Physical Scientist in the Public Health Chemistry Branch (PHCB) of the Exposure Methods & Measurements Division (EMMD), within the National Exposure Research Laboratory, under the Office of Research and Development of the U.S, Environmental Protection Agency since 2002. He received his Ph.D. degree in Soil Science from The Pennsylvania State University, his Masters degree from Texas A&M University and his

Bachelors degree from The University of Rhode Island. His research interests include the use of high resolution mass spectrometry (HRMS) to investigate the fate and transport of perfluorinated compounds and other xenobiotic compounds in biological and environmental media. Additionally, he is interested in novel compound discovery in environmental media and development of analytical methods for unique biomarkers of exposure to chemicals that are useful for dosed animal or human epidemiological studies.

When not at work he enjoys spending time with his family, volunteering at his local church, playing softball, and boating at local lakes. He is an avid white-tailed deer hunter and spends countless hours walking in the woods or suspended in the air in his tree-stand doing his part to control the overpopulated deer herd in his community. He is also an avid woodworker and welder and can be seen spending many hours in his workshop creating furniture, contraptions, saw dust and metal filings.
