Supply list:

12x12 canvas

Palette

Brushes: 1/4 " to 1" flat; #6 round for details

Paint colors: Ultramarine blue, Alizarin crimson, pthalo blue, white, yellow, burnt sienna, burnt umber, cadmium red and whatever other colors you need to paint your pet.

Drawing pencils, kneaded eraser, ruler

Masking tape, scissors or mat knife

Paper towels, water container, apron
