3	Crossrail Course B- Crossrails 2x COUNTERCLOCKWISE	Trot or Canter crossrails around two times-COUNTERCLOCKWISE; can be HANDY COURSE
4	Under Saddle	Walk, Trot, Canter; judging horse and rider
Mini-Hunter Division - 6-8 jump course; jumps of mixed height from crossrail to 2ft.		
5	Course A	Trot or canter, series of fences in a set course
6	Course B	Trot or canter, series of fences in a set course
7	Under Saddle	Walk, Trot, Canter; judging horse and rider

42	Adult Western Walk, Jog	Walk, Jog; Back in lineup.
43	Adult Western Pleasure	Walk, Jog, Lope; Back in lineup.
44	Adult Country Pleasure Racking - Flat Shod	Walk, Rack. Back in line up.
45	Open Ranch-Walk, Jog	Walk, Jog, Extended Jog; Back in lineup. Working horse, not Pleasure
46	Open Ranch-Walk, Jog, Lope	Walk, Jog, Extended Jog, Lope; Back in lineup. Working horse, not Pleasure
47	Juvenile Country Pleasure-Flat shod	Walk, Rack. Back in line up.
48	Adult English Walk, Trot	Walk, Trot. English Tack.
49	Adult English Pleasure	Walk, Trot, Canter. English Tack.
50	Flat Shod Racking	Walk, Rack, Rack On. Any breed racking horse.

Rules and Fees

Adult: over 18 years old / Juvenile: 17 yrs & under (unless noted otherwise) / Beginner: any age, 4 years or less showing total for the rider.

Gate Fee: \$5 per person; 12 and under free

Administration Fee: \$10 per RIDER per show

Per-Class Registration Fee: \$10/Member, \$15/Non-member

HELMETS WILL BE REQUIRED FOR ALL JUMPING CLASSES-NO EXCEPTIONS; UNDER 18 WILL HAVE TO SIGN WAIVER TO GO WITHOUT

*****Negative Coggins - Required by Georgia Law*** Coggins will be checked and copied for our records**

Western or English Tack - Casual dress or show attire (pants and close-toed shoes required)

SESSION 1 - Online PRE-REGISTRATION ONLY...registration CLOSES Wednesday before show @ midnight

SESSION 2 ONLY - Online Registration CLOSES Thursday @ midnight before show. In-Person Registration OPENS 2 hours prior to the start.

****Registration for the first 4 classes of SESSION 2 closes 15 minutes prior the start of the show.****

MIDWAY SADDLE CLUB GENERAL RULES

- 1 The judge's decision is final and judge may NOT be approached during the show.
- 2 No juvenile's will be allowed to show a stallion in any class.
- 3 No boot, false tails, crops or full bridles (4 rein bridles) are allowed in any country pleasure or trail classes.
- 4 No boots, false tails or switches are allowed in show pleasure classes, however you may ride with a crop and full bridle (4 rein bridle) if desired.
- 5 No chains, leather rings, knocker boots or other action devices are allowed in any class. Bell boots and heel boots are allowed in performance classes.
- 6 To receive a refund, your horse must be scratched at least 2 classes prior to the class from which the horse is being removed.
- 7 No disorderly conduct allowed or tolerated, no alcohol allowed.
- 8 Dogs are allowed ONLY IF on a leash, with rabies tag prominent; MUST clean up after dog, and it MAY NOT cause distraction in the ring.
- 9 The ringmaster has the authority to remove any horse from the arena deemed out of control.
- 10 If a class is cancelled by the BOD due to safety concerns, double points will be awarded at the subsequent show.
- 11 If showing in a Pre-Beginner class, the rider is not eligible to show in any Walk, Trot, Canter classes.
- 12 Beginner classes will be split with 10 entries and all other classes split with 16 entries.
- 13 Riders may show in 2 jumping divisions. The Crossrail and Mini-Hunter division or the Mini-Hunter and Hunter division.

The BOD reserves the right to cancel OR split any class. Midway Saddle Club will not be held responsible for any accident or injury.
