Our Class Teacher will:

- Inspire children and instil a love of learning through a wide range of creative teaching styles
- Work as a team with fellow teachers
- Produce weekly plans for mathematics and English and unit plans for all other subjects, as directed
- Maintain a well organised, pupil friendly and interactive learning environment
- Assess, record and report pupil progress according to school policy
- Promote and organise a range of curricular and extracurricular activities, for example, productions, assemblies, trips, speakers and after school clubs
- Manage pupil homework, according to school policy
- Liaise with school's Inclusion Manager to prepare individual pupil support
- Build good relationships with pupils and parents
- Promote and safeguard the welfare of pupils, maintaining a constant awareness of all issues relating to child protection
- Be involved in decision making and policy development across the school in consultation with whole staff, where appropriate
- Attend meetings before and after school, including the occasional twilight meeting, as necessary
- Support and guide teaching assistants
- Fulfil other reasonable duties as directed by the Head Teacher
