The Fair Work Ombudsman (FWO) has announced that it recovered a record \$532 million in unpaid wages and entitlements for 384,000 workers in the 2021-22 financial year. The amount was more than three times the record amount recovered in the previous financial year. In the 2021-22 year, the FWO filed a record 137 claims in courts, almost double the number of the previous year.

The FWO currently has around 50 investigations underway into large corporations, including some of Australia's largest companies.

Financial penalties of up to \$666,000 for corporations and \$133,200 for individuals apply for failing to pay employees their correct entitlements. Back-pay for up to six years can also be ordered.
