emergency closings a delays

Please be reminded of the Care After School policy regarding emergency dismissals. If emergency conditions such as snowstorms, facility problems, etc., cause the school day to be altered, CAS will follow these guidelines:

- If the schools are <u>closed for the day</u>,
 CAS is closed.
- If the start of school is <u>delayed</u>, the CAS <u>before</u> school program is closed, but the <u>after</u> school program will be in session.
- If the elementary schools dismiss at their regular time but the <u>middle</u> <u>schools or high schools</u> are dismissed early for an emergency, CAS is closed.
- If the elementary schools are dismissed early for an emergency, CAS is closed.

Cancellation information will be posted on the CAS website and an email will be sent to inform parents about emergency dismissals. Please make sure CAS has your daytime email on file. All families must have an emergency release plan on file. Please ensure your child is aware of the plan in the event CAS is cancelled unexpectedly.
