Students selected as scholarship recipients will be notified by May 10, 2024.

## **Eligibility Requirements:**

- 1. Applicant must have been a Club member or a current member of the Boys & Girls Club of Southeast, Alabama. A sibling or relative's membership will not qualify the applicant as a former Club member.
- 2. Applicant must be a High School Junior or Senior
- 3. Applicant must be a U.S. citizen.
- 4. Applicant must submit all required attachments with completed application form.

#### **Selection Criteria:**

Applicants will be selected based on:

- 1. Scholastic achievement (i.e. grade point average)
- 2. Character and leadership (i.e. extra-curricular involvement, achievements, personal references)
- 3. Essay responses

#### **Required Attachments:**

Please include all of the following with our completed application form. Any application forms that are submitted without these required attachments will be ineligible. Please review your package carefully before submitting it.

- 1. One letter of recommendation; This letter may come from a teacher, school administrator, church member, community member or a personal reference. The letter must have the reference's name, address and phone number. References should include how long they have known you and in what context. References should not be related to you by blood or marriage.
- 2. A one to two page essay, "What does the Boys & Girls Club mean to me?"

#### Awards:

A total of one \$1,000.00 scholarship will be given out to one deserving high school junior or senior that was a former Club member or a current Club member of the Boys & Girls Club of Southeast, Alabama.
