Life skills:

Your child can follow instructions and ask for help if needed.

Classroom Basic

Your child can identify colours Your child can hold a crayon or pencil correctly

Literacy Basics:

Children will sit and listen quietly to a story Your child will look at pictures in the book independently

Numeracy and mathematic basics

Your child can recognize basic shapes Your child can count using one to one correspondence


