

LMC's 2024 Budget

Copies of the preliminary budget for next year will be available in the church office and on the member's section of our website. Most of the changes from last year are in salaries, wages, and benefits. Programs, salaries, and utilities add up fast, but we try to be responsible with the gifts God provides us. We rely on the generosity of our members to meet the needs of the congregation and the community.

Seasons of the Church

We are presently completing the longest season of the church year. Pentecost - Paraments were green for growth. It was an opportunity to examine your heart, study God's word and reach out to others. How did you do? There are a few Sundays left that we celebrate special times. The first being The Reformation which took place October 31, 1517. Martin Luther posted the ninety-five Theses on the door of the church in Wittenberg. It's the work of God in preserving and reforming the church in time of trial and defending the truth. Red is for zeal and martyrdom.

All Saints Day is November 1st and celebrated after the Reformation commemorating the martyrs and all the people of God, living and dead. The paraments are white pointing to eternity and perfection which all saints now enjoy.



The last Sunday of the church year we celebrate Christ the King pointing to the second coming of Christ... That leads us right into the Advent Season. A time to prepare our hearts for Jesus coming... My! How quickly the year has passed.

Luther's Mission Garden

October has brought us a bunch of surprises!!

From torrential rains that flooded the garden and toppled our tent to the garden visit from <u>Senator Vin Gopal!!</u>

With the evenings getting darker earlier, we've continuously been moving our harvest times earlier. And with the weather turning cooler, the crops are slowly petering out!! The end of the season is coming soon!! One by one, the plants and vines are being torn down, and the hoses and stakes are being prepared for winter storage. We only have a few more harvests left.

Open Church Board Positions for 2024

We depend on the wonderful volunteers that help with the administrative portions of our church and preschool. Every year we have elections at the December voter's meeting to determine who will be serving in each open position for the next year.

We have several open positions to fill this year. Please prayerfully consider if you can help in any of these important service activities.

- **President** Runs monthly Board meetings and any Voter's Meetings. Meets with Pastor, Elders, boards, and committees to make sure things are going well (1 year term)
- **Vice President** Chairperson of the Preschool Board runs their meetings and ensures the Preschool has everything it needs. Also, puts together the slate of candidates for all positions each year and fills in for the President as needed. (1 year term)
- **Director of Outreach** Encourages the Congregation to share the Word and invite people to church. Hosts and attends events to increase our connection to the community. (2 year term)
- **Director of Education** Makes sure our bible studies, Sunday School, VBS, etc. have everything they need. Encourages the congregation to learn more about their faith. (2 year term)
- **Public Relations Director** Uses traditional and social media to advertise the church and our events (2 year term)
- **Preschool Treasurer** Reviews and keeps the financial records of the Preschool
- Preschool Board Member- Attends meetings and helps our Preschool stay on track
