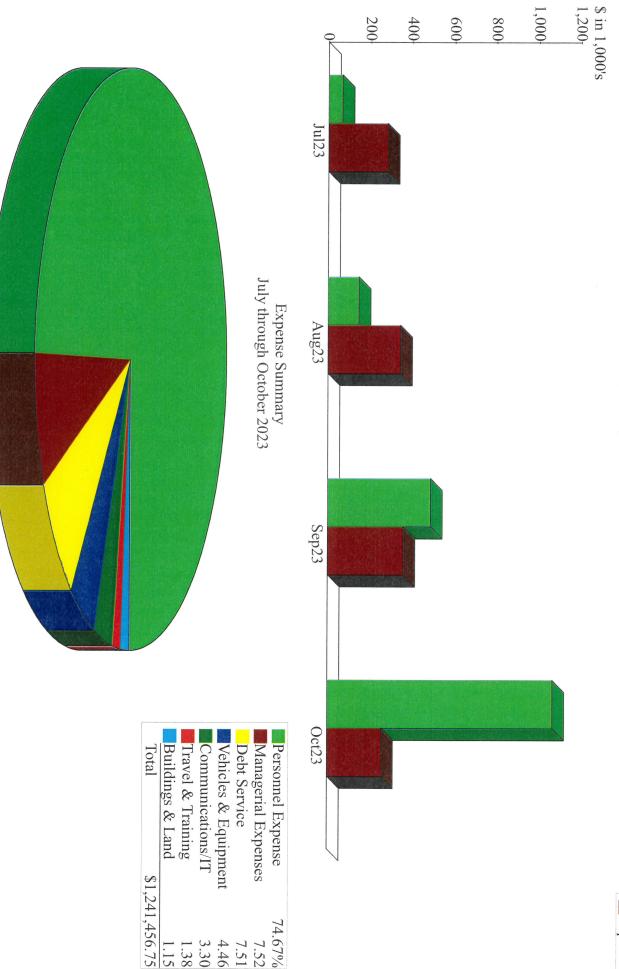

We have audited the financial statements of the governmental activities, the business-type activities, the aggregate discretely presented component units, each major fund, and the aggregate remaining fund information of Heber-Overgaard Fire District for the year ended June 30, 2023. Professional standards require that we provide you with information about our responsibilities under generally accepted auditing standards (and, if applicable, *Government Auditing Standards* and the Uniform Guidance), as well as certain information related to the planned scope and timing of our audit. We have communicated such information in our letter to you dated

July 31, 2023. Professional standards also require that we communicate to you the following information related to our audit.

Significant Audit Matters

Qualitative Aspects of Accounting Practices

Management is responsible for the selection and use of appropriate accounting policies. The significant accounting policies used by Heber-Overgaard Fire District are described in Note 1 to the financial statements. No new accounting policies were adopted and the application of existing policies was not changed during 2023. We noted no transactions entered into by Heber-Overgaard Fire District during the year for which there is a lack of authoritative guidance or consensus. All significant transactions have been recognized in the financial statements in the proper period.

Accounting estimates are an integral part of the financial statements prepared by management and are based on management's knowledge and experience about past and current events and assumptions about future events. Certain accounting estimates are particularly sensitive because of their significance to the financial statements and because of the possibility that future events affecting them may differ significantly from those expected. The most sensitive estimate affecting the financial statements was:

Management's estimate of the depreciation expense and useful lives is based on common practices for Fire Districts. We evaluated the key factors and assumptions used to develop the depreciation expense and useful lives in determining that it is reasonable in relation to the financial statements taken as a whole.

Certain financial statement disclosures are particularly sensitive because of their significance to financial statement users. The most sensitive disclosure affecting the financial statements were:

The disclosure of Retirement and Pension Plans in Note 9 to the financial statements which include estimates from actuaries and projects long term liabilities far in to the future.

Difficulties Encountered in Performing the Audit

We encountered no significant difficulties in dealing with management in performing and completing our audit.

Disagreements with Management

For purposes of this letter, a disagreement with management is a financial accounting, reporting, or auditing matter, whether or not resolved to our satisfaction, that could be significant to the financial statements or the auditor's report. We are pleased to report that no such disagreements arose during the course of our audit.

Management Representations

We have requested certain representations from management that are included in the management representation letter dated November 15, 2023.

Other Matters

We applied certain limited procedures to budgetary schedules and information, which is required supplementary information (RSI) that supplements the basic financial statements. Our procedures consisted of inquiries of management regarding the methods of preparing the information and comparing the information for consistency with management's responses to our inquiries, the basic financial statements, and other knowledge we obtained during our audit of the basic financial statements. We did not audit the RSI and do not express an opinion or provide any assurance on the RSI.

Restriction on Use

This information is intended solely for the information and use of Heber-Overgaard Fire District and management of Heber-Overgaard Fire District and is not intended to be, and should not be, used by anyone other than these specified parties.

AMENDMENT OF LEASE/PURCHASE AGREEMENT

THIS AMENDMENT (this "Amendment") to LEASE/PURCHASE AGREEMENT dated as of September 29, 2022 (the "Original Lease"), between Zions Bancorporation, N.A.., as lessor (the "Bank" or "Lessor"), and Heber Overgaard Fire District, as lessee (the "Lessee") is entered into in order to amend the Original Lease as set forth below.

Recitals

- A. The Bank and the Lessee entered into the Original Lease to finance the Leased Property described therein.
- B. The leased proceeds (the "Acquisition Amount") has remained in escrow with Zions Bancorporation, National Association ("Escrow Agent").
- C. Subsequent to the execution and delivery of the Original Lease, the vendor of the Leased Property was unable to manufacture and deliver the Leased Property in a timely manner.
- D. As a result of such non-performance, the Lessee entered into an agreement with the same vendor to use the Acquisition Amount to purchase a vehicle substantially similar to the Leased Property (the "Substitute Leased Property").
- E. The Lessee desires, and the Bank has agreed, to effectuate such substitution by removing the description of the Leased Property in Exhibit B of the Original Lease and replacing such description with a description of the Substitute Leased Property.

Agreement

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the parties hereto agree as follows:

- 1. Terms defined in the recitals hereto and in the Original Lease shall have the same meanings when used herein unless otherwise indicated.
- 2. <u>Exhibit B</u> of the Original Lease is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with Exhibit B attached to this Amendment.
- 3. All references to the Leased Property in the Original Lease shall refer to the Substitute Leased Property in Exhibit B attached to this Amendment and that any security interests created in Section 9.3 of the Original Lease shall be created against the Substitute Leased Property
- 4. The Lessee hereby reaffirms, ratifies, restates, and incorporates herein by this reference, as if made on the date of this Amendment, all of its representations, warranties, certifications, covenants, and designations set forth in the Original Lease regarding:
 - (i) the creation, existence, and operations of the Lessee;
 - (ii) the nature and use of the Leased Property; and
 - (iii) the requirements of Sections 103 and 141 through 151 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the "Code"), and the Treasury Regulations promulgated in connection therewith, pertaining to:

- (a) qualification for exemption of the interest components of the Lease Payments from the gross income of the owner thereof for purposes of federal income taxation;
- (b) the non-private activity use of the Leased Property;
- (c) the non-private activity sources of security for and payment of the Lease Payments;
- (d) the non-federal guarantee of the Lease Payments;
- (e) compliance with the federal arbitrage regulations; and
- (f) the designation of the Lease and the Lease Payments as a "qualified tax-exempt obligation" under Section 265(b)(3) of the Code;

and the Lessee hereby represents, warrants, and certifies that at all times since the execution of the Original Lease to and including the date of this Amendment it has complied with and will continue to comply with all of the foregoing representations, warranties, certifications, covenants, and designations referred to in this Section 4.

- 5. No event has occurred and continues which constitutes, or with notice or the passage of time or both would constitute, a default, an event of default, or an Event of Nonappropriation, as those terms are used and/or defined in the Original Lease.
- 6. Attached hereto as $\underline{\text{Exhibit } X}$ is the opinion of Lessee's counsel pertaining to the Original Lease and this Amendment.
- 7. In the event of any conflict or discrepancy between the Original Lease and this Amendment, the terms and provisions of this Amendment shall prevail. In all other regards, the terms and provisions of the Original Lease are hereby reaffirmed and shall remain intact, and all references to the "Lease" therein shall refer to the Original Lease as amended by this Amendment.
