Policy: McCrossan Boys Ranch will provide juveniles with a wide variety of services and programs appropriate to the needs of juveniles utilizing not only those services and programs provided in-house but also services and programs which can be provided by networking with other community agencies.

Procedures:

1. McCrossan Boys Ranch will provide or make provisions for the following services:
 - A. Educational, vocational, and psychological assessment
 - B. Educational and vocational programming
 - C. Individual and group counseling
 - D. Family counseling
 - E. Recreational and leisure activities
 - F. Work activities
 - G. Consistent family contact when appropriate
 - H. Food service
 - I. Assistance with transportation
 - J. Transitional services
 - K. Independent living skills
 - L. Medical/dental health services
 - M. Mental health services
 - N. Employment counseling and placement
 - O. Emergency financial assistance
 - P. Opportunities for community service work
 - Q. Drug and alcohol treatment
 - R. Family planning
 - S. HIV and Aids education
 - T. Special offender treatment

2. Access to services, programs, and activities, work assignments and administrative decisions for program beneficiaries and participants will be made without regard to the individual's race, sexual orientation, religion, national origin, political views or disability.

3. McCrossan Boys Ranch will regularly assess the needs of its juveniles for the purpose of implementing appropriate programming.
 - A. Formal needs assessment surveys will be administered annually to all employees and juveniles.
 - B. Staff and/or juveniles identifying needs can put them in writing and forward them to the Associate Director.
