#BOYSMATTER AND THEY NEED TO BE INCLUDED IN THE CONVERSATION OF

#EQUITY...

It's important to note that nationally boys are underperforming academically in comparison to similarly situated female peers across racial lines. Boys are opting out of attending #college at horrifying rates and driving up the ratio of boys to females enrolled in #collegiate courses. the #mentalhealth statistics for males in our country are staggering. This is equity - identifying areas of disproportionality and supporting them with fiscal resources and innovative solutions. Today I had a masters lesson on a #fieldtrip to Maymont. For context, there were six 2nd grade boys in my group, and through them, they either affirmed my beliefs (27yrs of experience) or taught me new concepts. Some examples:

#1. Boys require different types of #instruction. We need to establish experiential techniques that promote and elevate boys' learning engagement.

#2. Boys need more breaks. It is harmful for us to only give boys one break a day when they are so full of energy because their energy levels are often much higher than those of their female peers. This was made very clear when I looked around at the other groups that were primarily made up of girls; they were experiencing this field trip very differently than my #boys.

#3. Students should go on at least three to four field trips every year to broaden their experience. Field trips give #students access to experience, it says, which allows them to develop language and context for #reading, but these field trips cannot happen if instructors and

schools do not have appropriate support from parents and the community. Volunteerism should be included in all



employers expectations. We must lobby for businesses to encourage #volunteerism in schools, particularly those whom are labeled Title I (40% free and reduced lunch recipients). Additional #volunteers would help multiple school-wide efforts. For example, assisting with field excursions since instructors work so hard to guarantee our students have experiences, but it is very difficult when they do not have enough volunteers. Also, distict wide school staff should be required to support at least two student field trips a year.

#4. Executive functioning skills should be ingrained in every classroom.

Students, particularly boys, must master executive functioning abilities such as #self-regulation, which can be embedded in all of their coursework. For example, it can betaught through #karate or #taichi in lieu of general PE. It is absurd that we expect students to have a skill set that is not taught in our schools and for which boys often do not have a biological inclination.

This isn't to say that #girlseducation don't matter but #boyseducation matter as well and we need to see them.

P.S. Always bring wet wipes, first aid kits, backpacks, and extra water bottles on any field trip.

FROMNAVY BLUE TO CIVILIAN HUE

On a sunny day in June 1993, a young man stepped onto the grounds of the Recruit Training Center (RTC) in San Diego, ready to embark on a journey that would change his life forever

He was about to enter the US Navy's Boot Camp, a grueling two-month training program that would redefine his existence. For the next 13 and a half years, he would be a sailor, constantly going out to sea, participating in three Mediterranean deployments, and serving in the Antiterrorism/ Force Patrol unit. But in

the end, he would trade his active service for the title of Veteran, a transition that proved to be anything but smooth.

The discipline, camaraderie, and sense of purpose that had been his life's cornerstones suddenly seemed to vanish. He was thrust into a world where he had to carve out a new identity and find






