The first long trip of the season is coming up soon. Join us for the holiday week.

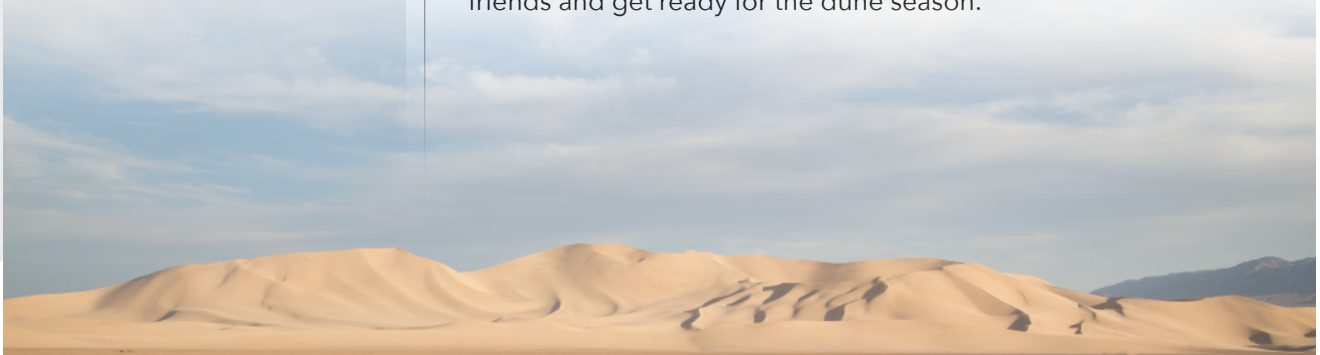
Sand Sports Super Show
