# 2.0 VATTENFALL LAUNCH SATURDAY 8<sup>th</sup> JUNE: -

All the plans for the event this coming weekend are falling into place; Emily asked how all the Directors have been getting on with the sales of tickets and any that were left over were distributed accordingly.

Emily spoke about the issue with cars possibly arriving on site during the day, Vattenfall have agreed that if any do turn up they may be accepted to park on site, also anyone who may walk that does not have tickets.

Fresh Delights Van will be on site in the day offering food and ice cream; there will also be a Chill Out bus that will be on site and then move to the Village Hall for 6:00pm-8:00pm, the children will be able to make their kites and other arts and crafts on the bus.
