2. Grants to parishes are allocated in accordance with a pre-agreed formula. Parishes who do not take their full grant each year have the balance of the grant reserved at the CIC.
3. Corporation Tax paid in 2020 relates to the year 2019.
4. As the Company is a not for profit making company the Accounts are prepared on the basis of Income and Expenditure.
5. The directors consider that the company is entitled to audit exemption under Section 477 of the Companies Act 2006 for the year ended 30th November 2020. The members have not required the company to obtain an audit of its accounts for the year ended 30th November 2020 in accordance with Section 476 of the Companies Act 2006. The directors acknowledge their responsibilities for complying with the requirements of the Companies Act 2006 with respect to accounting records and the preparation of accounts.
