Medical Illness Policy

When you should keep your child home:

- Fever is above 100 degrees
- Vomiting and diarrhea
- Flu: body aches, fever, headache
- Pinkeye

Keep you child home until he/she has no symptoms for a period of 12 hours.

When you should send your child to school:

- Ear infection; no pain
- Minor cold; runny nose, cough, sneezing and no fever is present
- Strep throat (after 24 hours of medication)
- Vague "I don't feel good" symptoms

You may be asked to pick up your child if he/she exhibits any of the following symptoms during the course of the school day:

- Fever is above 100 degrees
- Vomiting and diarrhea (2 episodes)
- Pinkeye
