

SWIMMING POOL SAFETY

MSN POOL PLASTERING takes swimming pool safety very seriously, and we offer the following information on how you can help keep your family safe:



1. Teach your children to swim.
2. Maintain adult supervision at all times, even if your children know how to swim.
3. We recommend that you not install a diving board, but if you choose to do so, periodic inspection of the board is necessary.
4. Insure that you have proper fencing, gates and locks and inspect them regularly to insure that they are functioning properly and self closing.
5. Learn CPR and maintain a first aid kit nearby.
6. Never swim when there is a possibility of lightening.
7. Never swim alone.
8. Do not leave air-filled toys or floats in the pool when not in use – they can tempt children to reach for them.
9. Do not allow electrical appliances near the pool.
10. Know the depth of the pool and the shape of the pool bottom before you dive. (Always Hands In Front)
11. Avoid drains and other suction outlets.
12. Keep grates and drain covers in good repair and properly secured in place.
13. Have your pool and pool equipment inspected by a professional on a regular basis.
14. Go over all pool rules with friends prior to swimming.. This is to cover you!
15. Keep a phone nearby in case of emergency 911.
