

Scripture Readings

While there are many possible scripture passages for use in a wedding service, these are the ones that are suggested for use in Lutheran wedding services. They are given for your guidance. If you would like to choose scripture not on the list, please be sure to consult with your pastor.

When choosing scripture, follow the typical pattern found in Christian worship for the proclamation of Scripture: a lesson from the Old Testament, followed by a Psalm that reflects on that lesson. Then a lesson from the New Testament is read. Finally a lesson from one of the Gospels is read.

Scripture in a wedding functions to announce the good news of God's activity in the lives of the ones being married, the families being joined together, and the community. Appropriate Scripture selections point to God as the source and giver of love and relationships. It should announce God's care for the whole human family. The New Revised Standard Version (NRSV) is used for the public reading of Scripture.
