The Jeweled Hart pattern in carnival was produced by Dugan. It can be found as an exterior pattern in the Farmyard, Petal and Fan and Smoothed Rays. The Jeweled hart pattern has been found in catalogs predating Carnival Glass and it was originally called Victor. The Carnival Glass 101 Site has an article DUGAN - Part 7 that shows a few examples of glass that the Jeweled hart was used as an exterior pattern.

The Water Pitchers and sets are only found in marigold; Dave Doty indicates that a white tumbler is known. The water pitchers and sets are hard to come by and it is really hard to find a pretty example. The picture above does not do justice to the piece, it is one of the hardest pieces of carnival that I have found to get a good picture of.
