American Carnival Glass Association, Inc. Northwood Peacock and Urn Chop Plates

The Peacock and Urn Chop Plates are not that readily available in any color. My Dad tells me Peacock and Urn chop plates are harder to find in white and marigold. David Doty reports that the following number of Northwood Peacock at Urn Chop Plates were sold in auction; 7 purple 2010 and 2013, 4 ice green chop plates from 2005 to 2012, 2 marigold in 2006 and 2007, and one white on eBay in 2007. The Northwood Peacock and Urn chop plate appears to have been made from the master ice cream bowl. The Northwood Peacock and Urn chop plate is not as flat as the Millersburg Peacock and Urn Chop Plate the edge of the Northwood plate can be as high as 2 inches or a little more. The Northwood chop plates are normally from 10 ½ inches to 12 inches wide depending on how high the edge of the plate would rise from a table; the white chop plate that was sold by eBay was measured 10 inches and was flatter than the other known white plate.
