**Sporting Clays:** Sundays 9:00 a.m. till 12:00 p.m. For after 12:00 p.m.—call the club at (315) 252-2031 to see if the course is open.

**Skeet:** Wednesdays (Skeet), 9 am —11 am (approx.)

Sundays (Trap & Skeet) 9:00 a.m. till 12:00 p.m.

**Shotgun Sports:** Limit shot size to 7.5 lead, No larger—No "Hi-Base" Loads

When shooting the above shotgun games <u>ALL</u> members and non-members must follow the Club Management Rules and Regulations that govern those games.

Members and non-members must sign the Shooting Log Book and pay for their respective shooting game BEFORE they shoot.

**Rifle Range:** Monday through Saturday 9:00 a.m. till dusk, unless a special event is being held. Sundays 3:00 p.m. till dusk, *unless the Sporting Clays field is open*.

## **ALL STATE & LOCAL LAWS MUST BE OBEYED!**

Eye and Hearing protection is mandatory while on club grounds!

## A note concerning the Rifle Range;

from April through October, Correction Officers from the Cayuga Correctional Facility rent the upper club house Monday through Fridays 8:00 a.m. till 3:00 p.m. and they use the Rifle Range for their training. If you are interested in using the Range during those times, please consult with the corrections officer in charge.

Also, when the orange warning flag is raised (pole in front of Rifle Range) NO shooting is allowed.

Only paper targets are to be used, glass bottles, cans or other types of targets are strictly prohibited.

Pick up all targets, trash, and wood, shell casing, etc. from the Rifle Range and carry them out with you.

NO smoking when using black powder.

Members <u>may not use</u> clay target traps or other club equipment unless a club officer or board member is present or notified before any use.

No hunting is allowed on club grounds unless a club officer / board member

Always Keep guns pointed in a safe direction.

Do not destroy or shoot objects such as signs or target stands, do not shoot in a manner that could result in rounds going over a berm.

Shoot in a controlled manner, such as is consistent with training for action pistol/shooting type sports (ex. USPSA, IDPA)

Anybody observed breaking the above rules may be subject to revocation or suspension of club membership.

Please respect your fellow member's privacy and refrain from any pictures or video recordings on the range.

NO alcoholic beverages are allowed on the rifle range or any field at any time!

Any changes, amendments, or exceptions to range guidelines must have written approval from the Board of Directors.

Please respect you fellow member's privacy and refrain from any pictures or video recordings on the range.

The pond is available for members and their families. -Natural Bait Only—All fishing is "Catch & Release"

All State & Local Regulations must be followed when using the pond!
