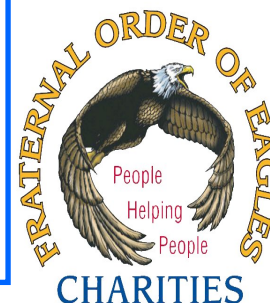

Officer Nominations

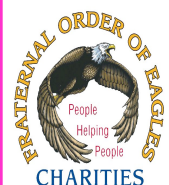
