ARRIVAL/CHECK IN

Goats may arrive anytime after 9 AM on Thursday, May 2nd. All goats must be checked in and measured by Saturday 8:00 AM.

SHOW RULES

Miniature Silky Fainting Goat Association rules shall govern this show. Refer to the MSFGA website www.msfgaregistry.org for complete show rules. All goats entered in the shows must be registered with the MSFGA. Over height animals will not be permitted to compete in the shows. Does must not exceed 23.5" at the withers and bucks must not exceed 25" at the withers. All animals will be measured by an official measurement committee.

AWARDS

Ribbons will be awarded through fourth place in all regular classes. Rosettes will be presented to Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion. Rosettes and Special Buckles will be presented to Best in Show.

RAFFLE

There will be a raffle table. The raffle will follow the Saturday afternoon shows. Tickets will be 15 tickets for \$20. If you would like to participate in the raffle by offering something to donate, please let Susan French know so that all items can be published with your farm name/name on the raffle list.

ENTRY & PEN FEES

The pen fee is \$18 per pen, \$10 for tack pen (no bedding). It covers both days and includes set-up, pine shavings, as well as, bedding removal after the show. Show pens are 5x6 and are constructed of goat panels. If you have little ones, you may want to bring some plastic mesh or puppy pens to line the show pens.

NOTE: You must provide your own hay.

ENTRY FEES ARE FOR ALL EIGHT SHOWS

NO ENTRY FEE FOR 10 OR MORE GOATS

***WETHERS- No entry fee

There will be no refunds for any reason.

Any entry submitted after May 2 will be accepted but will not be published in the show program.

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

Any goat exhibiting signs of infectious disease or symptoms of illness will not be permitted on the show grounds. This determination will be at the discretion of the show superintendent. Registered goats with a registration tattoo number accompanied by registration papers and a Scrapie Eradication Program premise identification number do not require a Scrapie ear tag. Intrastate goats must have a registration certificate, a registration tattoo number and a Scrapie Premise ID number.
