Paper Airplane Contest

Rules and regulations

- 1) The contest will consist of 5 minutes to construct a paper airplane from a single sheet of paper.
- 2) Then each player will be given a 2 minute window to throw their plane.
- 3) Failure to throw your plane by the time allotted will result in a no fly.
- 4) The plane must be launched by one person throwing it unaided from behind a straight launch line marked on the floor.
- 5) Touching the launch line or any point beyond during the launch is considered an invalid attempt.
- 6) After all planes are thrown for that round the distances are notated and a new member will attempt to make their airplane.
- 7) Each team will get three chances to construct and throw their planes. Each attempt is made by a different member from their team.
- 8) This means one member will construct, one member will throw for three rounds. This means all 6 members will be involved in the event.
- 9) Each team may choose who will construct and who will throw each plane, but no member may be involved twice during the contest.

Scoring

- 1. After Each plane is thrown the distance will be calculated for the planes that landed inbounds.
- 2. Any plane that is thrown out of bounds will not be calculated.
- 3. The points will be awarded by feet. So 1 point for every foot the plane is in the air.
- 4. The distance does not count any sliding across the ground.
- 5. If a plane flies 25ft and slides for 6 more feet the score is 25.
