Since chemical abortion is not a treatment for a disease, illness, or injury, but directly targets and kills a human being living and growing inside his or her mother's womb, in no sense can it be called "medicine." Abortion activists falsely call chemical abortion "medicine" as a ploy to convince women that killing their child is somehow a moral medical act when it is not.
