Relics and the Sacramentality of the Catholic Faith Part 1

What exactly, is a relic? Some people have referred to me as "an old relic". I guess in some ways I'm guilty as charged because I believe in making use of the ancient wisdom, especially the ancient wisdom of the Church. But in other ways, I believe in life and that in life, everything is changing all the time. It's a constant balancing act of maintaining the vibrancy of a life well lived, grounded in the rocksolid truths that are contained in God's creation.

The Oxford Dictionary says a relic is, "an object surviving from an earlier time, especially one of historical or sentimental interest." It's true the secular world, even in antiquity, preserved bone and artifacts of cult heroes. But for our purposes, for the Catholic understanding of relics, I think we need to understand something about the sacramental nature of our faith. We need to understand that God - who is pure spirit - became one of us, taking on human flesh and blood. Jesus Christ is both fully God and fully simultaneously man. He is perfectly divine and perfectly human, having two complete and distinct natures at once.

unity of soul and body is so profound that one has to consider the soul to be the 'form' of the body: i.e., it is because of its spiritual soul that the body made of matter becomes a living, human body; spirit and matter, in man, are not two natures united, but rather "their union forms a single nature". (CCC 365) When we say the soul is the 'form' of the body, we mean, as Aristotle stated, "The form is the structure, arrangement, and organization of matter that makes a particular

just like all human beings are body

and soul. The Catechism of the

Catholic Church teaches us, "the

object what it is." Our bodies are the 'matter', our souls are the form. The form of the chair is in the mind of the furniture maker, the matter is wood. The whole of creation was in the mind of God, the form. When God said, "Let there be light!" the universe exploded into being, the matter. The Big Bang! Everything, therefore, is sacred.

Pro-Life Apologetics

Pro-abortion claim: : Chemical abortion is safe for women

Pro-Life response: While abortion activists call the two-drug chemical abortion protocol a "gold standard" method for killing preborn babies, it is not without risk of serious harm and even death to the mother. Sold as "Mifegymiso" in Canada, product literature describes adverse reactions to include "persistent or heavy vaginal bleeding" that may require "treatment with intravenous fluids or blood transfusion"; "nausea, vomiting, diarrhea and abdominal pain"; "headache, dizziness, chills and fever"; infectious complications include "sometimes fatal sepsis" and infection that can lead "rapidly to multi-organ failure and death." Newspaper reports reveal that numerous women from around the world have died after chemical abortion.
