

Funny thing about being Catholic, although there is 2,000 years of the greatest thinking ever thought, the greatest philosophy, art, music, ideas, and concepts ever imagined, and arguments for the existence of God, our knowledge of God really depends on none of that. Our knowledge of God comes from our immersion in the Holy Spirit. That "knowledge is a function of an entire form of life, involving prayer, selfdenial, the corporal and spiritual works of mercy, and the forgiveness of one's enemies. We don't think our way to an understanding of God so much as we live our way to it." Bishop Robert Barron

That is the sacramental worldview. We live our faith in and through our bodies and souls. We are carnal creatures, flesh and blood that has meaning and is sacred. We are animated by our soul, that is life comes from the Spirit, our soul is the nexus, our point of connection with God and where we receive his abundant grace.

We live our way to an understanding of God, says the good bishop. Our faith is a lived experience; it is not an adjunct to our lives. Our faith is meant to be lived through and through. Like the body and soul are one, our faith should be who we are as well, not what we are. "I'm catholic" describes who I am, not what I am such as a priest, a police officer or a hockey player.

Wouldn't you agree that the parish in which you are a parishioner should achieve the goal of saving souls by being a joyful, happy place? Don't you think it should be a place that is open to strangers, a community that reaches out to folks who don't know Jesus? I certainly do and I hope you see the possibilities there.

After the family, the most important part of living our faith is living the parish life. The parish exists to sustain the lives of parishioners both spiritually and socially and those two aspects are also intertwined.

We've been keeping the church open, exposing the Holy Eucharist, as much as we can, ever since Hamas invaded Israel. Perhaps you don't realize and don't really see the benefit of doing this but those of us that are here every day, especially those who sit and kneel in adoration, know there is something good happening. Having the church open from morning till evening allows people who are passing by to drop in. People who are hurting or depressed come in to find sanctuary from the world.

This is just one example of a parish community contributing to the common good, to bring some peace in this world.

This is one important aspect of the vision I have for this parish, and I hope to develop it further with your help. I see the parish as a community that provides for the needs, especially spiritual needs, of everyone we encounter. It is in reaching out and touching the other that we find our joy. It is in the encounter with the other that we receive grace. Our Lady of Lourdes, pray for us. And, Happy Mother's Day to all.




INTO THE BREACH




