Catholic Faith?


Did you ever wonder why there are so few people in the pews compared to say, 30 or forty years ago? In the past, Catholics would go to Mass on Sunday out of obligation, or out of tradition, cultural traditions, family traditions. It was nice to get together on Sundays and enjoy the family Sunday dinner. The people themselves were not that well catechized, meaning they didn't necessarily know the depths and the significance of what they were doing. But it was 'good' to go to Mass.

But as modernism creeped into our world, into our families, into our schools, the notion of absolute truth was knocked off its pedestal and 'truth' became relative to each person. And so our children learn that we don't really need God, that we don't need some fanciful authority figure to tell us what is right and wrong. So naturally the children strayed from the Church and their children, therefore, don't know anything about the faith. Maybe they are baptized, maybe not. Maybe they baptize their children because the grandparents would like it but there is no faith lived in the household.

So there are fewer people in the church and they are not getting any younger. And there is a shortage of priests. The Church is the Body of Christ and he is grieving the loss of so many people. So what should we do? Shut'er down? Last one out shut the door and turn off the lights? NO! We need to fight back by


