

Light and Vision

The days are getting shorter and shorter. What a difference in the amount of sunlight between December 21 and June 21. And it's not just the number of hours of sunlight but the quality of the light itself that is quite different.

Light plays an important role in our lives, even affecting our emotional state at a primal level. Just think of the way we feel on a beautiful sunny morning as opposed to a dark rainy day, all other things being equal. There are certain aspects of our behaviour that change depending on whether it is day or night, artificial light, firelight, sunlight, candlelight, December, or June; all have profoundly different influences on us. Look around the church and notice how different it feels depending on the circumstances of the available light summer, winter, morning, afternoon, rainy or sunny. The natural light that comes through these windows has its own beauty in all circumstances.

Light has an important function in theology, in the liturgy and our ideas about our relationship with God. The very first action God takes in Genesis, while observing the earth as a formless wasteland at the moment of creation is to say, "Let there be light!" (Gen. 1:3) and there was light. Almost as if to say, "What could be more important than light?"

Vision is the faculty to be able to see. Another definition of vision is "the ability to think about or plan the future with imagination and wisdom".

I've been thinking about a vision for the future of Our Lady of Lourdes parish a lot lately and particularly about our

basement reno project. For the project to come to fruition, it requires vision that is, vision in the sense of planning for the future with imagination and wisdom.

Presently, there exists a dark, empty shell of a room with inadequate, unpleasant light, making for an unhospitable, unfriendly atmosphere.

Let's face it; it's time to change that. I have a vision of that basement becoming a multi-use venue for social activities of all kinds, allowing us to welcome people into our church; a place with amenities that could serve the people, connect people, inspire people to bring other people to Christ.

That's my vision. Do you share the vision I propose? Or do you have another idea? I would very much like to know what your vision is.

How do you like the idea of a lift to bring people from inside the church to the basement and the washrooms (without havina travel outside in elements)? Our Project Advance Campaign donations will be going toward the cost of a lift as part of the overall renovations.

There will be natural light coming in through windows that were shuttered up many years ago. Natural light will play a role in making the downstairs hall a beautiful, welcoming, friendly, sociable space.

Light is life and knowledge. Darkness is ignorance and death. "I came into the world as light, so that everyone who believes in me might not remain in darkness." John 12:46 Jesus is the light of the world.

Let us together prepare a vision for this now desolate space and turn it into a beautiful reality for present and future parishioners.
