1st Reading: Genesis 9.8-15

2nd Reading: 1 Peter 3.18-22 Gospel: Mark 1.12-15

You Are the Hope of the World

The world is losing hope. We can tell it's losing hope by the way we devise ingenious means of killing innocent human life. Abortion and euthanasia are dire signs of hope ebbing out of the human community. That's the truth.

The world is losing hope. We can see it in the wild world of the entertainment industry, in the vacant eyes top models, in a culture that glorifies death and fantasizes about super antiheros who simultaneously want to destroy the world and save it. Death abounds in the hundreds of crime programs on TV. Death sells. Body counts mount in mass shootings. And people are losing hope.

Forty years ago, China, fearing the possibility of a "population explosion", decided engineer to their population by implementing a "one child" policy, a policy that would use abortion as the primary tool to achieve their tragically misguided goals. Girl children were not wanted which led to a completely disproportionate number of girls killed by abortion. They number in the millions.

Today, there are not near enough women

around to bear children and a huge number of men have no chance of finding a mate. They are lonely and angry. Women have lost interest in having families, there are no siblings. There has been a precipitous drop in fertility. The Chinese government has engineered themselves into a deep hole. It's a monumental tragedy.

We have two ways of bringing hope into the world: prayer and witness. Prayer is the answer to this tragedy and the strongest tool we have in our tool kit to create the scale of change of hearts and minds that is needed. St. Padre Pio said that "Prayer is the best weapon we have; it is the key to God's heart."

My dear parishioners, you are the hope that this world needs. Are you not willing to pray and to witness to the world that life is precious and sacred? I was down at the vigil site at 32nd and Willow this Thursday. St. Anthony of Padua parish was praying there. They told me that so far, they have 186 people signed up to pray at the vigil site over eight days. That's an average of 24 people per day.

Pro-Life Apologetics

Pro-abortion claim: Abortion empowers women


