We also have many parishioners praying in the church and, I hope, many more are praying at home or elsewhere having pledged to pray for the cause of life during these forty days.

The point is, we cannot really know what effect we are having. It's hard to measure the results of prayer. The only indication we had from last year's campaign was that a doctor called the archdiocesan office and asked us to stop because we were upsetting some women who were coming in for "necessary abortions". I guess meant that some abortions necessary, and others are not. I wonder if he does the "unnecessary" ones as well. In any case, that was a sign that we are having an effect because there is no such thing as a "necessary" killing of an innocent human life.

We never really know the mind of God and his workings, but I think, maybe as a result of all this prayer, he has tipped his hand and has led us to begin working directly with an organization called Pregnancy Concerns.

This applies to all members of the human family, born and unborn. A civilization is judged by how it treats its weakest members, especially those with anomalies in the womb.


