We are in Christ and Christ is in us. This is our true relationship with God. We walk around as if God was 'out there somewhere', external to us. He's not; he's in you and me and we are in him. This is how we are all connected. We're all members of the Mystical Body of Christ and we live in a sacramental world in which all is sacred.

All that God created is good - and sacred. God did not create sin or death; he only allowed it. We humans choose sin and death.

St. Paul tells us in Romans: "You are in the Spirit, since the Spirit of God dwells in you...If the Spirit of God who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you, he who raised Christ from the dead will give life to your mortal bodies also through his Spirit that dwells in you."

The Word became flesh. God, pure spirit, chose to take on a human body with all its beauty but also, all its fragility, its vulnerability, its emotions, its mortality. Why would God do that? Love, that's all. Love for you and me. And that's the reason he suffered and died for us. That's why he marched up to Jerusalem, doing battle with the Pharisees all along the way.

It's also why he left us the Sacraments especially the 'source and summit' of

our faith, the Holy Eucharist, Christ himself. He humbled himself even further, as if that were possible. But he did; he allows the gifts of bread and wine to be changed into his Body and Blood, his Soul and Divinity and he allows us to eat him, ingest him, literally make him physically and spiritually part

When we realize all of this, we need to behave as if God was in us and that we are walking tabernacles, temples of the Holy Spirit. We are one with God. There is no more intimate relationship than that.

And so it is good to converse with our intimate relationships. With God, we call this prayer. We talk, He listens. We are quiet, he speaks. We listen.

But how do we know our prayer is being answered?

First, trust that it is being answered. Be persistent. Be quiet and listen.

Since we have opened up the church for adoration most every day, I have noticed certain things happening in subtle ways in the parish, things like more people in the pews both at daily Mass and the Sunday Masses.

The prayer effort we have been putting on for the 40 Days for Life campaign is also bearing fruit.


Pro-Life Apologetics

Pro-Life response: Abortion is the direct and intentional killing of a preborn human being living within his or her mother. Miscarriage is the unintended and naturally occurring death of a preborn human in the early stages of pregnancy. Medically helping a mother who has miscarried to empty her uterus by means of a dilation and curettage procedure (D&C) is not an abortion. This procedure, invented in the late 19th century, existed prior to legal abortion, and will continue to be morally and legally used to help women who miscarry or who have other gynaecological conditions in pro-life nations that have banned abortion.
