

The Lord's Day

One of the talks given to us this week by Father Raymond de Souza at the Clergy Study Week was about The Lord's Day and how we perceive the idea of The Lord's Day and how we observe it. He mentioned that many of us will refer to our Masses on Saturday evening and Sunday as 'weekend Masses'. Upon reflection I'm sure I'm quilty sometimes saying 'weekend Masses' when I mean, 'The Lord's Day Masses'.

What's the big deal? What difference does it make if we say weekend Masses Sunday Masses. Well, a little background is in order.

Although the Lord's Day is rooted in the very work of creation and even more in the mystery of God resting on the seventh day, it is nonetheless to the Resurrection of Christ that we must look to understand fully the Lord's Day. This is what the Christian Sunday does: it leads the faithful each week to ponder and live the event of Easter, true source of the world's salvation.

" 'I am with you always, to the end of the age.' (Mt 28:20). This promise of Christ never ceases to resound in the Church... As the day of Resurrection, Sunday is not only the remembrance of a past event: it is a celebration of the living presence of the Risen Lord in the midst of his own people."

Dies Domini, JPII, Apostolic Letter para 31, 1998

As I mentioned, it started at the creation. But early in the founding of the Jewish Faith and Culture, Moses was ordered by God to organize the people in a liturgical way. And of the many rules, laws, and regulations that were implemented, two things emerged over time as essential

to the survival and the preservation of the faith: the Sabbath and the Temple. History has shown us that the Sabbath is enduring. The Temple served its purpose until it was replaced in the New Covenant of Jesus Christ who has become the New Temple, but the Sabbath lives on.

When we live according to the rhythm of the Sabbath, we are in much closer contact with our spiritual connection with the divine. How we observe the Sabbath is important. The day of rest is meant to give us a differentiation from other days. It is to allow us to rest, and to delight in our family and close friends, to share God's gifts, to stop engaging in commerce for a day. To praise God on HIS Day, the Lord's Day.

We live in a culture that has a great resistance, if not an outright denial, of the transcendent. When Catholics live by our liturgical calendar, we stay much more connected to the authentic rhythm of life. Doing so helps us to live our faith in a world that has disdain for our faith and helps us thrive as the counterculture we are. When we give Sunday over to commerce or the secular way of thinking, we stay locked in the horizons that prevent us from seeing the heavens.

The weekend is NOT a Christian concept. It is a commercial concept.

The ancient wisdom of the Sabbath is liberation, not burden. The weekend belongs to the secular world; the Lord's Day is Christian. So let us speak of our Masses on Saturday evening and Sunday as "The Lord's Day Masses", not the weekend masses. And let us devote the Lord's Day to God and our families.
