Adoration is respect, reverence, strong admiration, or love in a certain person, place, or thing. The term comes from the Latin adōrātiō, meaning "to give homage or worship to someone or something". Wikipedia



There is only one whom we should adore and offer that kind of homage - this is the Lord. Last week we started opening the church as much as possible for Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament as a response to the atrocities committed in Israel and the bloodbath that is continuing, not only in Israel and Gaza but in Ukraine and other places. As I mentioned last week, human solutions are nowhere to be found. We seek the Lord's intervention. The people Nineveh were spared certain destruction because they heard Jonah's message from God to repent. They did repent and a calamity was prevented.

To pray before the Blessed Sacrament, to sit in adoration of our Lord is a very powerful prayer.

28th SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

1st Reading: Isaiah 45.1, 4-6 2nd Reading: 1 Thess.1.1-5ab Gospel: Matthew 22.15-21

When it is done in community, with intention, it is especially powerful. From the world's perspective, adoration looks like a pathetic and futile attempt to change world events. But the world fails to see itself through the lens of sacred scripture and especially the teachings of Jesus Christ. It fails to see how our Lord is at work in the world, that he has a mission that is being carried out by his faithful. It doesn't acknowledge the numerous, inexplicable miracles that happen every day in the name of Jesus, tossing them aside as irrelevant.

Miracles happen every day and, if you are Catholic, you must know that and believe that is true. And if you know that to be true, you need to act in solidarity with us who are building a wall of prayer to help stop war.

The prayer doesn't change God; the prayer changes us and the world. And that is the point, we are all sinners and we all need to repent for our sins and offer sacrifice in reparation for them.

Our parish's venture into Eucharistic Adoration began spontaneously and without any kind of structure. I'm convinced all good things begin that way. But it is difficult to maintain continuity without a schedule and firm commitments to cover the Holy Hours. Please consider being part of a team that will guarantee the church will be open for prayer and adoration for many hours throughout the day. It will take a team of adorers who will influence others to join them. Make a commitment to pray in front of the Eucharist once a week. Make a commitment to bring peace to the world.






