

To Make New Again

St. Francis of Assisi, while praying at the church of San Damiano, heard Jesus speak to him from the crucifix, "Francis, go rebuild my church which is falling down." So Francis started renovating the church which was in pretty bad shape. It seemed a reasonable request but along the way it gradually became clear to him that it wasn't the church building that Jesus meant was in need of repair, it was Church proper that needed renovation. There was no small amount wandering away from Gospel principles in the early thirteenth century and St. Francis and his little band of men grew into the Franciscan movement that played a role in bringing the Church back to holiness. You could say it was a Divine Renovation.

Renovation is an interesting word. From the Latin re –again and novare – to make new. To make new again. I used the example of St Francis because I'm trying to describe the twofold process that is necessary for Our Lady of Lourdes Parish to become new again.

When it was a new parish, it was full of zeal and an unwavering commitment of the people, the French Canadians newly arrived from Québec, with a single mind to make the church the center of their lives. This is physically represented by Laval Square. The Church is the center and the homes were built all around it.

But that was then. We do not want to return to the past but we do want to build on it. In last week's reflection, I spoke about vision.

STEWARDSHIP REFLECTION

I asked you to think about what is your vision of Our Lady of Lourdes' future. I can tell you something about my vision for this parish and it includes both types of renovation. In a nutshell, I want to make the parish new again. I want it to be vibrant and holy and reaching out with open arms. My vision of the future of the parish includes а welcoming congregation that has the goal of bringing the Good News of Jesus Christ to others, and to be a beacon of compassion and mercy neighborhood named after our first pastor, Curé Edmond Maillard. I'd like to see a parish that is clearly led by the Holy Spirit.

I'd like to see the physical renovation of the church basement play a major role in the Divine Renovation that is going on at the other level I just mentioned. Having an operating, multi-functional space that will feed our parishioners needs and attract others to come and use our facilities will go a long way to renewing the legacy of Our Lady of Lourdes. It will become central to the lives of everyone in the neighborhood - if that is our shared vision.

Our Project Advance Campaign is central to making this a reality in the near future. I would ask you, if you have not already contributed, to seriously consider giving something, even if it's a small amount. Consider the question: What is your vision for Our Lady of Lourdes? And act on it.
