Wouldn't it be great if we had no need of fences or boundaries that keep us from going where we want to go, doing what we want to do, and just enjoy total freedom without restriction? In two or three weeks, it will be painted white with brown trim mimicking the façade of the church. The hope is to bring back the original character of the church with a fence that will keep the critters out and let lovers of the garden in.

Fences, in a sense, are like rules. We need them to regulate how we do things in the interest of the common good. In life, we have to play by the rules and the rules were set up in the dawn of creation. Some of the most important rules are gravity, which holds everything together in balance, and entropy which is the law Father Larry that things fall apart.

So, yes I will do it because it is what I came here to do and it is the way of salvation for countless souls.

And Jesus tells us that if we want to follow him, we too, will need to "take up our cross". We will do things that are difficult but necessary for our salvation. Things we don't want to do. Not do things we do want to do. To go in when we don't want to and to not go in when we do.

It's all necessary because that is how God's creation works. And oddly enough, when we follow the rules, that's when we find liberation and true freedom.

The man responsible for getting the fence up is our custodian, Terence Mazon. He has only been here for one month and a half and he has made a major impact on fighting entropy on our parish campus. In this short time, he has repaired many things and got us back on track for winning the battle against entropy. Unfortunately, he will soon be moving with his family to Manitoba. 





