## STEWARDSHIP REFLECTION

### “This is where you find me. Everywhere you look.”

What does Jesus say upon seeing the Apostles for the first time after his Resurrection? Does he say, “There you are, you dirty scoundrels. I found you, you pack of cowardly mongrels!”? No. He does not. He says, “Shalom.” Or “Peace be with you.” This is the peace that the Apostles were seeking; it is the peace that we are seeking; it is the peace that mankind has been seeking since Adam and Eve. It is the peace, the serenity that comes from participating in the very life of God. And God wants that peace for us.

To participate in the life of God means to participate in God in all things. That is because God is in all things. Nothing exists if God does not will it so. And since God is in all things, his presence in the world and in the Christian life is always active, always drawing us deeper into the Mystery of Christ and the Mystery of the Resurrection. When we understand this, we understand that our relationship with the world is our relationship with Jesus.

All of Jesus’ post resurrection appearances begin to help the Apostles to have a better understanding that he has become the universal Christ. **He is everywhere and urging our world to a point of convergence with the Father.**

There are points where the Risen and Transformed Christ is crystalized and focused – where he is present with unusual power. These are sacramental moments. We find them when we’re reading Scripture, in the breaking of the bread, baptism, reconciliation, anointing, and gathering in prayer. Jesus comes to us – he appears – not in triumphant, victorious display but as an enabling sign to say, **“This is where you find me. Everywhere you look.”**



His Resurrection changed the fabric of the universe and now, Christ is available to us always and everywhere. Now, we can begin to view the world in a sacramental way, a world in which everything is sacred and every created thing is pointing us to God and lifting us into his life.

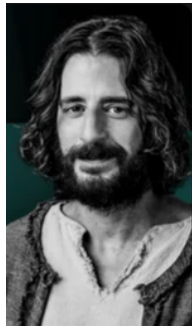

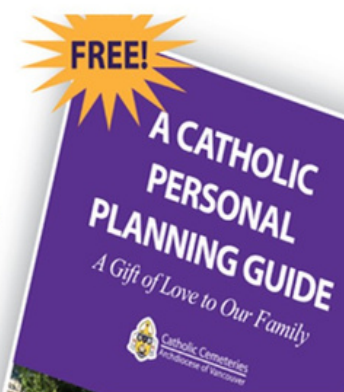
